

CHEVRON TANK



Size: 12 (16)

NOTE: figures in brackets () refer to larger size. Where

only one figure is given this refers to both sizes.

Skill Level: intermediate

How much yarn:

g 250 (350) of Milo yarn, in orange shade no. 8684 **Needles:** Pair of 4.50 mm (no. 7) knitting needles

Crochet hook: A 4.00mm (no. 8) hook

Sewing needle: Yarn needle with rounded point

Other items: 4 stitch-holders

STITCHES

Using needles: garter stitch (g st) - stocking stitch (st st). Using hook: double crochet (dc).

TENSION

30 sts and 30 rows (measured straight on centre) measure 10cm square over st st with 4.50 mm (no. 7) needles.

INSTRUCTIONS

Back: with 4.50 mm (no. 7) needles cast on 120 (132) sts. For border, work 4 rows in garter st. Then work as follows: **Next row (RS):** 1 selvedge st, SK1P (= slip 1 st, knit 1 st, pass slipped st over K1), K 26 (29), yfd (yarn forward), K1, yfd, K 28 (31), K2tog, SK1P, K 28 (31), yfd, K1, yfd, K 26 (29), K2tog, 1 selvedge st. **Next row (WS):** Purl. Rep these 2 rows. When work measures 30 (33) cm (measured on side) from beg, shape armholes. Cast

off 5 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Dec 1 st at each end, inside 1 st, on next and every alt row 8 (10) times. There are 94 (102) sts. When work measures 46 (49) cm (measured on central point) from beg, shape neck. Divide piece in the middle and work separately on each side, dec on neck edge 2 sts every row 14 (16) times. When work measures 6 (7) cm from neck shaping, leave on a stitch-holder rem 19 sts on each shoulder.

Front: work as Back.

FINISHING

With yarn needle, graft shoulders in kitchener st. Sew side seams. With 4.00 mm (no. 8) crochet hook work a round of dc all around neck-edge and armholes.
