## ONline Linie 282 ZICO

All knitting is done with fine part of yarn between pompoms and long tubes. Between stitches, hold the pompom with the left hand and knit only on the thin part. All other stitches are worked in this same manner. When working start of each row, leave one small pompom loose and unworked at each end of the row.

To cast on, start with the small pompoms section (The first stitch is cast on between a small and a large pompom). Work a backwards loop cast on as follows: make a slip knot on the skinny part of the yarn and place on needle. \*Skip a pompom, [wrap skinny part of yarn around thumb and insert needle into yarn]; rep from \* to end. (The last stitch cast on is between a large and small pompom. There should be a small pompom left over before the start of the first row.



## Lengthwise knitted Scarf Finished measurements

Width: 6" (16cm) Lenth: 59" (150cm)

Materials: 200g ONline Linie 282 ZICO, Circular Needle: US Size 7 (4.5 mm), Notions: Tapestry Needle.

Garter Stitch: Knit every row. Knit two stitches between the pompons

**Gauge:** Gauge is not important for this project.

Pattern: Cast on 60 sts. Work even in Garter stitch, working only on the space in between the pompoms and large tubes. When work measures 6" bind off all sts as follows: K2, pass first stitch over second, \*skip a pompom, K1, pass first stitch over second, K1, pass first stitch over second; rep from \* to end.
