

Teel Rag Scarf

Finished Measurements

Approximately 8in x 60in.

Materials

1 spool of Euro Yarns' Tee Rag.

Gauge

Irrelevant for this project.

Credits

Garment design and photography by Karen Klein.

Note!

Always make knots using groups of two ends of yarn.

Always use square knot (knotting left over right, right over left).

Always place knots approximately 2" apart.

Instructions

Cut 12 ends, each 140 inches.

Row 1: Knot together across first row in groups of two, using a square knot leaving 6 inches fringe. This will create the first row consisting of 3 knots total.

Row 2: Now knot together the interior two strands of each knot from the previous row (you will skip the first two and last two strands.)

This will create a second row of 2 knots total. *See illustration*.

Repeat rows 1 & 2, alternating between 3 knots per row followed by 2 knots per row. End after row 2.

Cut remaining ends to create 6in fringe. Tighten knits throughout scarf and block finished scarf by lightly stretching in all directions.
