


TOLLEGNO DAL1900



FEELING RIBBED CARDI

SIZE

Italian size 44 = US size 10 (approx. Medium).

MATERIALS

- 19 50g balls of Lana Gatto FEELING shade #12504 Grey.
- One pair size US 8 (5mm) needles or size to obtain gauge.
- One pair size US 6 (4mm) needles or size to obtain gauge.
- Tapestry needle with rounded point.

STITCHES

USING KNITTING NEEDLES:

Tubular stitch (work on odd number of sts)

Row 1: k1, * wyif, slip 1 st purlwise, wyib, k1, rep from * to end. Row 2: wyif, slip 1 st purlwise, * k1, wyif, slip 1 st purlwise, wyib, rep from * to end. Rep these 2 rows.

3x3 Rib

Row 1: * k3, p3; rep from * to end. Row 2: k the knit sts and p the purl sts. Rep Row 2 for k3, p3 rib.

Sailor's rib (work on odd number of sts)

Row 1: * p1, k 1-below (knit 1 st inserting needle into st of row below); rep from * to last st, p1.

Row 2: k1, * p1, k1, rep from * to end.

Rep these 2 rows throughout for Sailor's rib.

USING TAPESTRY NEEDLE:

Sewing in back stitch.

GAUGE

17 sts and 34 rows to 4in/10cm over Sailor's rib, with 2 strands held tog, using size US 8 (5mm) needles.

NOTE!

All pieces are worked with 2 strands of yarn held tog throughout.

ABBREVIATIONS

BACK

purl

Using size US 8 (5mm) needles, cast on 81 sts and work 4 rows in Tubular st. Then work in Sailor's rib with a selvedge st on each side. When piece measures 18½/in/46.5cm from beg, shape armholes binding off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows and 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Work even until armhole measures 5½/in/14cm. Shape neck. **Next row (RS)**: work 25 sts, join another ball of yarn and bind off center 19 sts. work to end.

Working both sides at once, bind off from each neck edge 3 sts and 2 sts twice. Bind off rem 18 sts for shoulder.

LEFT FRONT

Using size US 8 (5mm) needles cast on 39 sts and work 4 rows in Tubular st. Then work in Sailor's rib with a selvedge st on each side. When piece measures 10½zin/26,5cm from beg, shape neck dec 1 st inside last 2 sts on RS rows every 8th row 15 times alternating p2tog and SSK (slip 2 sts separately to right needle as if to knit, slip left needle into these 2 sts from left to right and knit them together: 2 sts become 1 st), as pattern requires. There are 24 sts. Work even until neck shaping measures 7¾in/20cm. Shape armhole binding off 4 sts at beg on next row (RS), and 2 sts on following alternate row. When piece measures same as for Back shoulder, bind off rem 18 sts.

RIGHT FRONT

Work to correspond to Left Front, reversing all shaping. Dec for neck shaping alternating p2tog and k2tog.



FEELING RIBBED CARDI

SLEEVES

Using size US 8 (5mm) needles, cast on 31 sts and work 4 rows in Tubular st. Then work in Sailor's rib with a selvedge st on each side. Inc 1 st each edge, inside selvedge, every 12th row 8 times, alternatig M1k (Make 1 st knit = insert left needle from front to back under strand between last st worked and first st on left needle. Knit, twisting strand by working into loop at back of needle) and M1p (Make 1 st purl = insert left needle from front to back under strand between last st worked and first st on left needle. Purl, twisting strand by working into loop at back of needle from left to right). Work all inc sts in Sailor's rib. When Sleeve measures 17½in/43.5cm, shape cap binding off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows, then dec 1 st inside first and last st on next RS row and every 6th row 3 more times, every 8th row twice. When sleeve cap measures 6in/15cm, bind off rem 23 sts.

EDGING

Using size US 6 (4mm) needles, cast on 297 sts. Work 4 rows in Tubular st and continue in 3x3 Rib until edging measures 4in/10.5cm. Do not bind off. Leave sts on a spare needle.

FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams. Set in sleeves, then sew side and sleeve seams. Join Edging sts on last row along opening and neck shaping of Fronts and Back, starting at lower edge of Right Front. Sew in back stitch with tapestry needle
