



SUPERSOFT
CABLED PULLOVER



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SIZE

Italian size 44 = US size 10 (approx. Medium).

MATERIALS

- 10 50g balls of Lana Gatto **SUPERSOFT** shade #13235 Yellow Gold.
- One pair size US 4 (3.5mm) needles or size to obtain gauge.
- One pair size US 6 (4mm) needles or size to obtain gauge.
- One pair size US 8 (5mm) needles or size to obtain gauge.
- Cable needle.
- Tapestry needle with rounded point.

STITCHES

USING KNITTING NEEDLES:

Tubular stitch (work on odd number of sts)

Row 1: k1, * wyif, sl 1 st purlwise, wyib, k1, rep from * to end.

Row 2: wyif, sl 1 st purlwise, * k1, wyif, sl 1 st purlwise, wyib, rep from * to end.

Rep these 2 rows.

Tubular stitch (work on even number of sts)

Row 1: k2, * wyif, sl 1 st purlwise, wyib, k1, rep from * to end.

Row 2: wyif, sl 1 st purlwise, * k1, wyif, sl 1 st purlwise, wyib, rep from * to last st, k1.

Rep these 2 rows.

Stockinette stitch

2x2 Rib (multiple of 4 sts plus 2)

Row 1: *k2, p2; rep from * to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 2: k the knit sts and p the purl sts.

Rep Row 2 for 2x2 Rib.

3x3 Rib (multiple of 6 sts plus 3)

Row 1: *k3, p3; rep from * to last 3 sts, k3.

Row 2: k the knit sts and p the purl sts.

Rep Row 2 for 3x3 Rib.

Cable pattern (multiple of 6 sts)

Row 1 (RS): k3, * sl 3 sts to cable needle and hold to back of work, k3 sts, k3 sts from cable needle (Right-slanted cable); rep from * to last 3 sts, k3.

Row 2 and even rows (WS): p.

Rows 3, 5 and 7: k.

Row 9: * sl 3 sts to cable needle and hold to front of work, k3 sts, k3 sts from cable needle (Left-slanted cable); rep from *

to end.

Rows 11, 13 and 15: k.

Row 16: p.

Rep Rows 1-16 for Cable patt.

USING TAPESTRY NEEDLE:

Back stitch

GAUGE

18 sts and 25 rows to 4in/10cm over Stockinette st, using size US 8 (5mm) needles.

21 sts and 25 rows to 4in/10cm over Cable patt, using size US 8 (5mm) needles.

BACK

Using size US 6 (4mm) needles cast on 99 sts. For waistedge work 4 rows in Tubular st and 12 rows in 3x3 Rib.

Change to 8 (5mm) needles and work in Stockinette st, dec 15 sts evenly distributed across first row. Dec 1 st each side every other row twice and every 10th row 4 times. 72 sts rem. Cont evenly until piece measures 8in/20cm from waistedge. Inc 1 st each side every 4th row 10 times. At the same time, when piece measures 10in/26cm from waistedge cont in Cable patt. When piece measures 13 ³/₄ in/35cm from waistedge, shape armholes.

Next (dec) row (RS): k2, sssk (= sl 3 sts separately to right needle as if to knit, sl left needle into these 3 sts from left to right and knit them tog: 3 stitches become 1), cont in Cable patt to last 5 sts, k3 tog, k2.

Next row: p. Rep last 2 rows twice more.



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Next (dec) row (RS): k2, sssk, cont in Cable patt to last 5 sts, k3 tog, k2.

Next row: p.

Next row: k5, cont in Cable patt last 5 sts, k5.

Next row: p.

Next (dec) row (RS): k2, sssk, cont in Cable patt to last 5 sts, k3 tog, k2.

Next row: p.

Next row: k5, cont in Cable patt last 5 sts, k5.

Next row: p.

Next row: k5, cont in Cable patt last 5 sts, k5.

Next row: p. 72 sts rem.

When armhole measures 7in/17.5cm shape neck.

Next row (RS): work 18 sts, join a new ball of yarn and bind off center 36 sts, work to end.

Working both sides at once, bind off from each shoulder edge 6 sts every other row 3 times. No sts rem.

FRONT

Work as Back until piece measures 4 ³/₄in/12cm from armhole. Shape neck. Bind off center 12 sts. Work separately both sides at once, binding off at each neck edge every other row 3 sts twice, 2 sts twice and 1 st twice. When piece measures same length as Back, bind off from each shoulder edge 6 sts every other row. No sts rem.

SLEEVES

Using size US 6 (4mm) needles cast on 48 sts. For cuff work 4 rows in Tubular st and 12 rows in 3x3 Rib. Change to 8 (5mm) needles and work in Stockinette st, dec 8 sts evenly distributed across first row. Inc 1 st each side every 5th row 18 times. There are 76 sts rem. At the same time, when piece measures 10in/26cm from cuff cont in Cable patt.

When piece measures 13 ³/₄ in/35cm from cuff, shape cap.

Next (dec) row (RS): k2, sssk, cont in Cable patt to last 5 sts, k3 tog, k2.

Next row: p.

Rep last 2 rows twice more.

Next (dec) row (RS): k2, sssk, cont in Cable patt to last 5 sts, k3 tog, k2.

Next row: p.

Next row: k5, cont in Cable patt last 5 sts, k5.

Next row: p.

Rep last 4 rows 4 times more.

Next (dec) row (RS): k2, sssk, cont in Cable patt to last 5 sts, k3 tog, k2.

Next row: p.

Rep last 2 rows 4 times more. Bind off rem 24 sts.

COWL

Using size US 4 (3.5mm) needles cast on 136 sts. Work 4 rows in Tubular st and 56 rows in 2x2 Rib, working 1 selvedge st at beg and at end of each row. When cowl measures 7in/18cm, leave all sts on a spare needle.

FINISHING

Sew sleeve seams. Sew cowl seam, sewing last 4³/₄in/12cm on RS to Reverse cowl. With tapestry needle sew cowl sts from spare needle to neckedge, all around, in Back st. Set in sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams 



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
