

# **BELL JUMPER**



Size: 10/12 (14/16) UK Size: 6/8 (10/12) USA Size: 36/38 (40/42) EU

**NOTE:** Figures in brackets ( ) refer to larger size Where only one figure is given this refers to both sizes

Skill Level: advanced

How much yarn: g 500 (600) of Cashmere Light yarn,

in orange shade no. 8433

Needles: Pair of 5.50 mm (no. 5) knitting needles A Double-pointed (Dp) needle. A spare needle Sewing needle: Yarn needle with rounded point Other items: Four stitch-markers. Two stitch-holders

#### **STITCHES**

**Using needles:** stocking stitch (st st)

Reverse stocking stitch (rev st st) - K1, P2 rib - K1, P1 rib. 10-ST CABLE: work on 10 sts.

Row 1: K10. Row 2 and even following rows: P10. Row 3: K10. Row 5: 10 Left crossed stitches (= place next 5 sts onto Dp needle, on frontside, K next 5 sts, K5 from Dp needle). Rows 7, 9 and 11: K10. Row 12: P10. Rep these 12 Rows for Cable.

8-ST CABLE: work on 8 sts.

Row 1: K8. Row 2 and even following rows: P8. Row 3: K8. Row 5: 8 Left crossed stitches (= place next 4 sts onto Dp needle, on frontside, K next 4 sts, K4 from Dp needle). Rows 7 and 9: K8. Row 10: P8. Rep these 10 Rows for Cable.

6-ST CABLE: work on 6 sts.

Row 1: K6. Row 2 and even following rows: P6. Row 3: 6 Left crossed stitches (= place next 3 sts onto Dp needle, on frontside, K next 3 sts, K3 from Dp needle). Rows 5 and 7: K6.

**Row 8:** P6. Rep these 8 Rows for Cable.

FANCY RIB: work on even number of sts. Row 1: \* P1, yb (yarn on back), slip 1; rep from \* to end. Row 2: \* yf (yarn on front), slip 1; yb (yarn on back), K1; rep from \* to end. Row 3: K all sts. Row 4: P all sts. Rep these 4 Rows for patt.

### **TENSIONS**

20 sts and 24 rows measure 10 cm square over rev st st with 5.50 mm (no. 5) needles. 20 sts and 24 rows measure 10 cm square over fancy rib with 5.50 mm (no. 5) needles. Cable on 10 sts: 4 cm wide.

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

Front: cast on 130 (138) sts and work 6 rows in K1, P2 rib. Cont as follows: 18 sts in fancy rib, 19 (21) sts in rev st st, 10 sts in 10-st Cable, 36 (40) sts in rev st st, 10 sts in 10-st Cable, 19 (21) sts in rev st st, 18 sts in fancy rib. When work measures 15 (17) cm from rib border, on each of 3 rev st st stripes dec 1 st at each end every 10th row 4 times and, at the same time, after 5th rep of 12 rows on 10 st-Cable, dec 2 sts at centre of both Cables and cont to work 8-st Cable. There are 102 (110) sts on needle. Then, on either side stripe in rev st st dec 1 st at each end every 10th row once more, meanwhile on large centre stripe on rev st st dec 1 st at each end alternately every 6th and 4th row (every 6th row) 4 times in total. 90 (98) sts remain. When work measures 34 (37) cm from rib border, shape armhole raglans: dec 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows and place a stitch-marker at either side for raglan start. 86 (94) sts remain. Cont to work as follows: 8 sts in rev st st, 8 sts in 8-st Cable, 9 (11) sts in rev st st, 8 sts in 8-st Cable, 20 (24) sts in rev st st, 8 sts in 8-st Cable, 9 (11) sts in rev st st, 8 sts in 8-st Cable, 8 sts in rev st st. Now, on either side of large centre stripe in rev st st dec 1 st at each end every 6th row twice and, at the same time, in the middle of 4 side stripes in rev st st (2 stripes on each side) dec 1 st every 6th row twice. 74 (82) sts remain. Then dec 2 sts at centre of 4 Cables and cont to work 6-st Cables. 66 (74) sts remain. In the middle of first and last stripe in rev st st dec 1 st every 6th row once more, meanwhile in the middle of other two side stripes dec 1 st every 6th row twice. At the same time, on either side of large centre stripe in rev st st dec 1 st at each end every 6th row twice. 56 (64) sts remain. Work 6 (8) rows, then dec 4 (5) sts only on centre stripe. Work other 6 (8) rows, then dec 2 (3) sts on centre stripe and 1 (2) sts on halfway stripes in rev st st. Leave rem 48 (52) sts on a spare needle.

Back: work as Front.

Sleeves: cast on 44 (50) sts and work 8 rows in K1, P1 rib. Work first and last 17 (20) sts in reverse st st and Cable on centre 10 sts. Inc 1 st at each end every 10th (8th) row 8 (9) times. There are 60 (68) sts. When work measures 42 (44) cm from beg, shape raglans. Cast off 3 (4) sts at beg of next 2 rows, then dec 1 st at each end every alternate row 21 (23) times. Leave on stitch-holder rem 12 (14) sts.

Neckband: place on same needle the 12 (14) sts of Left Sleeve, the 48 (52) sts of Front, the 12 (14) sts of Right Sleeve and the 48 (52) sts of Back. [= 120 (132) sts]. Work 4 rows in K1, P2 rib, dec 6 sts evenly on first row [= 114 (126) sts]. Then work **next row (RS):** \* K1, P2, K1, P2 tog; rep from \* to end. 95 (105) sts remain. Work other 3 rows, knitting the K sts and purling the P sts. Cast off all sts loosely.

## **FINISHING**

With yarn needle, sew raglan seams. Remove the four stitchmarkers. Sew side and sleeve seams.
