



THE COLOR EVOLUTION



SQUARE COLOR JERSEY

MATERIALS

CASHSILK LIGHT by LAINES DU NORD:

6 balls of color 3041 (dark blueish green) (MC)

1 ball each of color: 3000 (ochre), 3002 (light pink), 3042 (cream), and 3022 (salmon).

A pair each of US6/4mm, US7/4.5mm and US8/5mm needles.

SIZE

40"/101cm

SKILL LEVEL

Intermediate

ABBREVIATIONS

RS = right side

WS = wrong side

sts. = stitch/stitches

K= knit.

P = purl

dec = decrease

inc = increasing

rep = repeat

foll = following

stocking st. = stocking stitch (RS knit, WS purl)

rev. stocking st. = reverse stocking stitch (RS purl, WS knit)

skpo = slip 1 stitch, K1, pass slipped stitch over.

BACK

Worked horizontally

With US 8/5mm needles and MC cast on 63sts and work as follows:

Row 1: (RS) Knit to end.

Row 2: Purl to end.

Rep the last 2 rows for a further 18 rows.

Use colors of your choice for color block patt, work as follows:

Row 21: (RS) K28MC, P9 in color of your choice, K13MC, P9 in color of your choice, K4MC.

Row 22: K the K sts and P the P sts in colors set.

Rep the last 2 rows for a further 12 rows.

Row 35: (RS) Using MC, K2tog, knit to end.

Row 36: Purl to end in MC.

Rep the last 2 rows 3 times more.

Row 43: K2tog, K22MC, P9 in color of your choice, K13MC, P9 in color of your choice, K4MC.

Row 44: K the K sts and P the P sts in colors set.

Rep the last 2 rows once more.

Row 47: Cast off 2sts and patt to end.

Row 48: Patt to end.

Rep the last 2 rows twice more.

Patt 4 rows.

Row 57: Knit to end in MC.

Row 58: Purl to end in MC.

Rep the last 2 rows 3 times more.

Row 65: K16MC, P9 in color of your choice, K13MC, P9 in color of your choice, K4MC.

Row 66: K the K sts and P the P sts in colors set.

Rep the last 2 rows for a further 12 rows.

Row 79: Knit to end in MC

Row 80: Purl to end in MC

Rep the last 2 rows 3 times more.

Row 87: Cast on and K2sts, knit until 18MC on right hand need, P9 in color of your choice, K13MC, P9 in color of your choice, K4MC.

Row 88: K the K sts and P the P sts in colors set.

Rep the last 2 rows twice more allowing for the extra 2 sts.

Row 93: Cast on 1 st, patt to end.

Row 94: Patt to end.

Rep the last 2 rows 3 times more.

Row 101: knit to end in MC

Row 102: Purl to end in MC.

Rep the last 2 rows 3 times more.

Row 109: K28MC, P9 in color of your choice, K13MC, P9 in color of your choice, K4MC.

Row 110: K the K sts and P the P sts in colors set.

Rep the last 2 rows for a further 12 rows.

Row 125: Knit to end in MC.

Row 126: Purl to end in MC.

Rep the last 2 rows for a further 18 rows.

Cast off.

FRONT

Work as given for back.

SLEEVE

With US8/5mm needles and MC cast on 55sts and work as follows:

Row 1: (RS) Knit to end.

Row 2: Purl to end.

Rep the last 2 rows twice more.

Row 7: K4MC, [P9 in color of your choice, K10MC] twice, P9 in color of your choice, K4MC.

Row 8: K all K sts and P all P sts in colors set.

Rep the last 2 rows for a further 12 rows.

Row 21: Knit to end in MC.

Row 22: Purl to end in MC.

Rep the last 2 rows for a further 8 rows.

Row 31: As row 7.

Row 32: As row 8.

Rep the last 2 rows for a further 12 rows.

Row 45: Knit to end in MC.

Row 46: Purl to end in MC.

Rep the last 2 rows for a further 8 rows.

Row 55: As row 7.

Row 56: As row 8.

Rep the last 2 rows for a further 12 rows.

Row 69: Knit to end in MC.

Row 70: Purl to end in MC.

Rep the last 2 rows for a further 8 rows.

Row 79: As row 7.

Row 80: As row 8.

Rep the last 2 rows for a further 12 rows.

Row 93: Knit to end in MC.

Row 94: Purl to end in MC.

Rep the last 2 rows for a further 8 rows.

Cast off.

Lower bands

With RS facing and using US6/4mm needles, pick up and 72sts evenly along the lower edge of the front.

Work as follows:

Row 1: * K2, P2, rep from * to end.

Row 2: K all K sts and P all P sts to end.
Rep the last 2 rows for a further 32 rows.
Cast off.
Rep on the back lower edge.

Collar

Join right shoulder seam.
With RS facing and US7/4.5mm needles pick up and K100sts evenly around back and front neckline.
Work 34 rows in K2, P2 rib as given for lower edge.
Cast off.

MAKEUP

Join left shoulder and neckband seams.
Sew in sleeves thus: pin centre point of sleeve cast off edge to shoulder seam and stitch to body working from underarm up to shoulder.
Sew up side and sleeve seams. Sew in all loose threads.
