



Eyelet Stitch T-Shirt



Size: UK 10 (12/14) – US 6 (8/10) – EU 36 (38/40) Note: figures in brackets () refer to larger size. Where only one figure is given this refers to both sizes.

Skill Level: easy

How much yarn: 5 (6) balls (each ball 50g and 125m) of Sugar yarn (100% Sugar Cane)

shade no. 8881 coral red

Needles: A pair of 4.00mm needles

Sewing needle: Yarn needle with rounded

point

STITCHES

Using needle: K2, P1 rib.

EYELET STITCH: (work on even number of sts.) **1st row:** 1 selvedge st, * P2tog, yrn (yarn round needle); rep from * ending with 1 selvedge st. Rep this row throughout.

TENSION

20 sts measure 10cm in width over eyelet st with 4.00mm knitting needles. Take time to check tension before starting work: it is essential to work to the stated tension to achieve success.

INSTRUCTIONS

Back: with 4.00mm needles cast on 108 (116) sts. For border, work 3cm in K2, P1 rib (= 6cm). Cont to work in eyelet st. When Back measures 35 (38)cm from beg, cast off all sts loosely.

Front: work as Back until Front measures 27 (29) cm from beg. Shape neck: cast off centre 36 (40) sts, join another ball of yarn and cont to work either side separately, casting off at neck edge every alternate row: 5 sts once, 4 sts once, 3 sts once and dec 1 st twice. When neck shaping measures 8 (9)cm, cast off rem 22 (24) sts on each shoulder.

Sleeves: with 4.00mm needles cast on 88 (92) sts. For border, work 3cm in K2, P1 rib (= 6cm). Cont to work in eyelet st. When Sleeve measures 20 (22) cm from beg, cast off all sts loosely.

FINISHING

Using yarn needle sew a shoulder seams.

Neck-border: with 4.00mm needles and right side facing, pick up and K 135 (143) sts all around neckedge, and work 2cm in K2, P1 rib. Cast off loosely in rib. Sew other shoulder and neck-border seam. Set in sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams.
