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# SULKA COWL

Design 3



## MATERIALS

Two 50g hanks of Sulka.

(photographed in shade Electric Blueberry 238)

One 6mm (US 10) short circular needle.

## TENSION

14 stitches and 21 rows to 10cm/4ins square over pattern using 6mm (US 10) needle.

## MEASUREMENTS

52cm/20½ins x 22cm/8½ins.

## ABBREVIATIONS

<b>k</b>	knit.
<b>p</b>	purl.
<b>pss0</b>	pass slip stitch over.
<b>s1</b>	slip one stitch
<b>tog</b>	together.
<b>yon</b>	yarn over needle.
<b>[square brackets]</b>	Work all directions inside [square brackets] the number of times stated.

## TO MAKE

With 6mm (US 10) circular needle, cast on 72 stitches and, working in rounds, continue as follows:

**Foundation round:** knit to end.

**1st round:** [k2, yon, s1, k1, pss0]to end.

**2nd round:** [k2tog, yon, k2]to end.

Repeat the last 2 rounds until cowl measures 21cm/8½ins from cast on edge, ending with a 2nd round.

Knit one round.

Cast off.

## TO MAKE UP

Sew in end.
