SHAWL WITH TASSEL

SKILL LEVEL

Easy

MATERIALS

Poema Nuance by Laines Du Nord

1 ball x 150 grams in any color of your preference (col. 313 shown)

A pair of US6/4mm knitting needles.

Darning needle, tape measure, cardboard strip 8"/20cm in length.

STITCHES

Stocking stitch (RS knit, WS purl)

ABBREVIATIONS

RS = right side inc = increase(ing)
WS = wrong side rep = repeat(ing)

st(s) = stitch(es) p = purl

k = knit

GLOSSARY

M1K = make 1 stitch thus: pick up horizontal loop lying between last stitch worked and next stitch and knit into back of loop.

skpo = slip 1, knit 1, pass slipped stitch over

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width 64"/162cm

Length (from top edge to point) 22"/56cm

SHAWL

With US6/4mm needles and beginning with orange section of yarn, cast on 12sts.

Row 1: (RS) Knit to end.

Row 2: Purl to end,

Row 3: (RS) (inc row) Slip 1 knitwise, M1K, knit to end.

Row 4: Purl to end.

Rep row 3 and row 4, 115 times more.

234 rows worked. (128sts)

Row 235: Knit to end.

Row 236: Purl to end

Rep the last 2 rows 3 times more.

Row 243: (RS) skpo (slip 1, K1, psso), knit to end.

Row 244: Purl to end.

Rep the last 2 rows until 12sts rem.

Cast off.

Sew in all loose threads.

FINISHING

Tassel: Use the red section of your yarn. Wrap yarn around the cardboard strip 40 times. On one side, cut the threads: there are 40 threads, 16"/40 cm in length. Fold the threads in half. For "head" shaping, using the same yarn, at approx. 1"/3cm from folding point, wrap yarn around the tassel several times. knot the ends to secure. Sew the head of the tassel on the lower point of your shawl (see the picture).
