ISADORA
USING TRENZAR & AMITOLA GRANDE



~ ISADORA ~

Approx. size

20.5 cm (8 in) deep (to points)
143 cm (56¼ in) circumference

Yarn

A. 1 x 100g ball of Trenzar
B. 1 x 100g ball of Amitola Grande

Needles

6 mm (US 10) circular knitting needle
20 stitch markers

Tension/gauge

14 sts x 26 rows to 10 cm (4 in) square measured over eyelet and stocking stitch patt using 6 mm (US 10) knitting needles.

Abbreviations

beg begin(s); beginning, **cont** continue(s); continuing, **dec(s)** decrease(s); decreasing, **foll** follow(s); following, **inc(s)** increase(s); increasing, **K** knit, **M1** make one (increase), **P** purl, **patt(s)** pattern(s), **pssso** pass slipped stitch over, **rem** remain(s); remaining, **rep** repeat(s); repeating, **RS** right side, **st** stitch(es), **st st** stocking (stockinette) stitch, **tog** together, **WS** wrong side, **yo** yarnover, **K2tog** Knit 2 sts together, **S2KP** slip 2 sts onto RH needle as if going to knit them together, K1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over the knitted stitch, **SSM** slip stitch marker.

Isadora cowl

Using 6 mm (US 10) circular needle and yarn A, *cast on 12 sts, place a stitch marker, rep from * 20 times. (240 sts).

Now work in rounds.

Foundation round 1 (RS)(dec): (K5, S2KP, K4, slip stitch marker - SSM) 20 times. (200 sts)

Foundation round 2: (P10, SSM) 20 times.

Change to yarn B and work 12 rounds in striped lace, garter st and eyelet edging as follows:

Edging round 1 (RS): (K1, yo, K3, S2KP, K3, yo, SSM) 20 times.

Edging round 2: (P10, SSM) 20 times.

Edging round 3: (K2, yo, K2, S2KP, K2, yo, K1, SSM) 20 times.

Edging round 4: (K1, P9, SSM) 20 times.

Edging round 5: (K3, yo, K1, S2KP, K1, yo, K2, SSM) 20 times.

Edging round 6: (K2, P7, K1, SSM) 20 times.

Edging round 7: (K4, yo, S2KP, yo, K3, SSM) 20 times.

Edging round 8: (K3, P5, K2, SSM) 20 times.

Edging round 9: (K4, yo, S2KP, yo, K3, SSM) 20 times.

Change to yarn A.

Edging round 10: (P10, SSM) 20 times.

Edging round 11: ([yo, K2tog] 5 times, SSM) 20 times.

Edging round 12: (P10, SSM) 20 times.

Change to yarn B and work 12 rounds in striped lace and eyelet patt setting sts as follows:

Lace round 1 (RS): (K1, yo, K3, S2KP, K3, yo, SSM) 20 times.

Lace round 2, 4, 6 & 8: (K10, SSM) 20 times.

Lace round 3: (K2, yo, K2, S2KP, K2, yo, K1, SSM) 20 times.

Lace round 5: (K3, yo, K1, S2KP, K1, yo, K2, SSM) 20 times.

Lace round 7: (K4, yo, S2KP, yo, K3, SSM) 20 times.

Lace round 9: (K4, yo, S2KP, yo, K3, SSM) 20 times.

Change to yarn A.

Lace round 10: (P10, SSM) 20 times.

Lace round 11: ([yo, K2tog] 5 times, SSM) 20 times.

Lace round 12: (P10, SSM) 20 times.

Work the last 12 rounds once more.

Discard all but last stitch marker (to mark where each round beg/ends) and work striped st st and eyelet stripes as follows:

Rounds 1-5 (RS): Using yarn B, Knit, SSM.

Change to yarn A.

Round 6: Purl, SSM.

Round 7 (eyelets): (yo, K2tog) to stitch marker, SSM.

Round 8: Purl, SSM.

Rounds 1-8 form the st st and eyelet patt.

Work rounds 1-8 twice more.

Next round: Knit, discard stitch marker.

Turn work and cast off using the picot cast off method on the

WS as follows:

Cast off 3 sts, *slip st on RH needle back onto LH needle, cast on 2 sts, then cast off 7 sts, rep from * until all sts have been cast off.

Making up

Sew in ends, press/block cowl as described on ball band.
