M A T E R I A L S

4 100g skeins of Ella Rae **Seasons**, in any shade (MC).

4 100g skeins of Ella Rae **Seasons**, shade #33 (CC).

1 pair US 10/6mm needles.

A B B R E V I A T I O N S

CC contrast color, k knit, MC main color, p purl, RS right side, WS wrong side.

I N S T R U C T I O N S

NOTE: This afghan is knit by alternating 2 rows of a darker color and 2 rows of the light color. The first row (RS) of each color is always knit.

HINT: For a tidy garter stitch edge, do the following on every row: Knit to the last 2 stitches. Slip these two stitches purl-wise.

B L A N K E T

Using CC (Color 33), cast on 152 stitches.

Rows 1 - 6: Knit. See hint above.

Shadow Knitting: See hint above.

Row 1 (RS): With MC, *Knit 19, place marker. Repeat from * across row.

Row 2 (WS): *P 19, K 19, slipping markers. Repeat from * across row.

Row 3: With CC, knit across row, slipping markers.

Row 4: *K19, P19. Repeat from * across row.

Repeat Rows 1 - 4 while keeping color sequence (alternate colors every 2 rows) until afghan measures approximately 58 inches or you have just enough of the CC to finish border.

B O R D E R

With CC, knit 6 rows. See hint above.

Bind off loosely. Weave in ends. ❖
