# MIRASOL HACHO – HAT & SCARF



## Juan scarf

#### materials

Three 50g hanks of Hacho (photographed in shade Coral Reef 303) Pair of 4mm (US 6) knitting needles

#### tension

22sts and 30 rows to 10cm/4in square over patt using 4mm (US 6) needles

#### measurements

19cm/71/4ins x 105cm/411/4ins

#### to make

Cast off.

With 4mm (US 6) needles, cast on 42sts.

1st and 3rd patt rows: [k4, p2]to end.

2nd and 4th patt rows: [k2, p4]to end.

5th and 7th patt rows: [k2, p4]to end.

6th and 8th patt rows: [p2, k2, p2]to end.

9th and 11th patt rows: [p2, k4]to end.

10th and 12th patt rows: [p4, k2]to end.

These 12 rows form the diagonal rib.

Rep the last 12 rows until scarf measures

105cm/411/sins from cast on edge,
ending with a wrong side row.

### Tintiri hat

#### materials

One 50g hank of Hacho (photographed in shade Coral Reef 303)
Pair of 4mm (US 6) knitting needles

#### tension

22sts and 30 rows to 10cm/4in square over st st using 4mm (US 6) needles

#### measurements

To fit small to average sized adult head

#### to make

With 4mm (US 6) needles, cast on 92sts.

1st rib row (right side): p2, [k4, p2]to end.

**2<sup>nd</sup> rib row:** k2, [p4, k2]to end. These 2 rows form the rib row.

Rep the last 2 rows until hat measures 2cm/3/4ins from cast on edge, ending with

a right side row.

Dec row (wrong side): k2tog, p4, [k2, p4]to last 2sts, k2tog. (90sts)

1st and 3rd patt rows: [k4, p2]to end.
2nd and 4th patt rows: [k2, p4]to end.
5th and 7th patt rows: [k2, p2, k2]to end.
6th and 8th patt rows: [p2, k2, p2]to end.
9th and 11th patt rows: [p2, k4]to end.
10th and 12th patt rows: [p4, k2]to end.
These 12 rows form the diagonal rib.

Rep the last 12 rows until the hat measures approx 18cm/7ins from cast on edge, ending 12th patt row.

#### Shape Crown

1st row (right side): [k2tog, k2, p2]to end. (75sts)

2<sup>nd</sup> row: [k2, p3]to end.

3rd row: [k2tog, k1, p2]to end. (60sts)

4th row: [k2, p2]to end.

5<sup>th</sup> row: [k2tog, p2]to end. (45sts)

6<sup>th</sup> row: [k2, p1]to end.

7th row: [k1, p2tog]to end. (30sts)

8<sup>th</sup> row: [k1, p1]to end.

9th row: [k2tog]to end. (15sts)

Break off yarn. Thread through 15sts.

Pull securely and fasten off.

### to make up

Sew up the side seam.
