## Materials

500 [600:600:700:700:800]g of Araucania Elqui Shade 1103 for Long Sleeved Cardigan. 400 [400:500:500:600:600]g of Araucania Elqui Shade 1109 for Short Sleeved Cardigan.

- 1 Pair of 3.75mm (US5) knitting needles.
- 1 Pair of 3mm (US2) knitting needles.
- 1 3mm (US2) 80cm circular needle.
- 5 Buttons for each cardigan.

#### Tension

20sts and 28 rows to 10cm, 4in, over stocking stitch using 3.75mm (US5) knitting needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

### **Abbreviations**

beg beginning alt alternate dec decrease(ing) foll following cm centimetres cont continue in inch(es) mm millimetres **a** grammes p purl rep repeat k knit st(s) stitch(es) tog together ws wrong side rem remaing rs right side

### **Special Abbreviations**

1x1 Rib.

1st Row: \*K1, P1, rep from \* to last st, K1.
2nd Row: P1, \*K1, P1, rep from \* to end.

St-St. Stocking Stitch.

1st Row: Knit. 2nd Row: Purl.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows. Rep 1st and 2nd rows.

M1. Make one stitch. Pick up loop between last and next st and work into back of this loop.

### Important

The quanties of yarn given are based upon average requirements and are therefore approximate.

### IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENTION TO ENSURE SUCCESS

If there are less stitches and rows to 10cm, 4in, change to a finer needles, if there are more stitches and rows to 10cm, 4in, change to larger needles.

Instructions are given for the smallest size, larger sizes are in square brackets.

Where only one figure is given this applies to all sizes. Where the figure 0 appears no stitches, times or rows should be worked for this size.

Owing to photograph and printing restrictions the colour reproduction is matched as closely as possible to the yarn.

## Left Front

Using 3mm (US2) needles cast on 56 [58:60:64:68: 70]sts.

1st Row: \*K1, P1, rep from \* to end.

1st row sets rib.

Rep 1st row until rib measures 8cm, 3in, ending with a rs row.

**Next Row:** Rib 2 [4:4:3:1:6], rib2tog, (rib 5 [6:8:6:6:6], rib2tog) 7 [6:5:7:8:7] times, rib 3 [4:4:3:1:6]. 48 [51:54:56:59:62]sts.

Change to 3.75mm (US5) needles and working in st-st (throughout) cont until Left Front measures 27cm, 10¾in, ending with a ws row.

Place marker at end of next row.

**Shape Neck** 

Next Row: Knit to last 2sts, K2tog (neck edge).

47 [50:53:55:58:61]sts.

Work 29 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in every foll 4th row. 40 [43:46:48:51:54]sts.

Shape Armhole

Next Row: Cast off 6sts, knit to end.

34 [37:40:42:45:48]sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Work 4 [4:4:4:6:6] rows dec 1 st at armhole edge in

every row **AT SAME TIME** dec 1 st at neck edge in 3rd row. 29 [32:35:37:38:41]sts.
Work 7 [9:11:11:9:11] rows dec 1 st at armhole edge in next and every foll alt row **AT SAME TIME** dec 1

in next and every foll alt row **AT SAME TIME** dec 1 st at neck edge in 5th [5th:5th:5th:3rd:3rd] and foll 0 [0:6th:6th:6th:6th:6th] row. 24 [26:27:29:31:33]sts. Work 34 [32:30:36:36:34] rows dec 1 st at neck edge only in 4th [2nd:6th:6th:6th:4th] and every foll 6th

row. 18 [20:22:23:25:27]sts.

Cont without shaping until armhole measures 19 [19: 20:21:22:23]cm, 7½ [7½:8:8½:8¾:9]in, ending with a ws row.

Cast off.

## **Right Front**

**Using 3mm (US2) needles** cast on 56 [58:60:64:68: 70]sts.

1st Row: \*P1, K1, rep from \* to end.

1st row sets rib.

Rep 1st row until rib measures 8cm, 3in, ending with a rs row.

**Next Row:** Rib 3 [4:4:3:1:6], rib2tog, (rib 5 [6:8:6:6:6], rib2tog) 7 [6:5:7:8:7] times, rib 2 [4:4:3:1:6]. 48 [51:54:56:59:62]sts.

Change to 3.75mm (US5) needles and working in st-st (throughout) cont until Right Front measures 27cm, 10¾in, ending with a ws row.

Place marker at beg of next row.

Shape Neck

Next Row: K2tog (neck edge) knit to end.

47 [50:53:55:58:61]sts.

Work 30 rows dec 1 st at neck edge in every foll 4th row. 40 [43:46:48:51:54]sts.

Shape Armhole

Next Row: Cast off 6sts, purl to end.

34 [37:40:42:45:48]sts.

Work 4 [4:4:4:6:6] rows dec 1 st at neck edge in 3rd row AT SAME TIME dec 1 st at armhole edge in every row. 29 [32:35:37:38:41]sts.

Work 7 [9:11:11:9:11] rows dec 1 st at neck edge in 5th [5th:5th:5th:3rd:3rd] and foll 0 [0:6th:6th:6th:6th:6th] row AT SAME TIME dec 1 st at armhole edge in next and every foll alt row 24 [26:27:29:31:33]sts

next and every foll alt row. 24 [26:27:29:31:33]sts. Work 34 [32:30:36:36:34] rows dec 1 st at neck edge only in 4th [2nd:6th:6th:6th:4th] and every foll 6th row. 18 [20:22:23:25:27]sts.

Cont without shaping until armhole measures 19 [19: 20:21:22:23]cm,  $7\frac{1}{2}$  [ $7\frac{1}{2}:8:8\frac{1}{2}:8\frac{1}{2}$ ]in, ending with a ws row.

Cast off.

### Back

**Using 3mm (US2) needles** cast on 115 [121:127: 133:139:145]sts and work in 1x1 rib for 8cm, 3in, ending with a rs row.

Next Row: Rib 5 [8:11:6:9:12], rib2tog, (rib 6, rib2tog) 13 [13:15:15:15] times, rib 4 [7:10:5:8: 11]. 101 [107:113:117:123:129]sts.

Change to 3.75mm (US5) needles and working in st-st (throughout) cont until Back measures 27cm, 10% in, ending with a ws row.

Work 30 rows more.

**Shape Armholes** 

Cast off 6sts at beg of next 2 rows.

89 [95:101:105:111:117]sts.

Work 4 [4:4:4:6:6] rows dec 1 st at each end of every row. 81 [87:93:97:99:105]sts.

Work 7 [9:11:11:9:11] rows dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row.

73 [77:81:85:89:93]sts.

Cont without shaping until armholes measure 19 [19: 20:21:22:23]cm,  $7\frac{1}{2}$  [ $7\frac{1}{2}$ :8:8 $\frac{1}{4}$ :8 $\frac{3}{4}$ :9]in, ending with a ws row.

Cast off

### Long Sleeves (Both alike)

Increases up Sleeves should be worked as follows:-

Work 1 st, m1, work to last st, m1, work 1.
Using 3mm (US2) needles cast on 57 [57:59:59:61:
61]sts and work in 1x1 rib for 8cm, 3in, ending with a rs row.

**Next Row:** Rib 3 [3:4:4:5:5], rib2tog, (rib 5, rib2tog) 7 times, rib 3 [3:4:4:5:5]. 49 [49:51:51:53:53]sts. **Change to 3.75mm (US5) needles** and working in

Change to 3.75mm (USS) needles and working in st-st (throughout) work 85 [89:96:96:89:101] rows inc 1 st at each end as shown above in 5th and every foll 8th [7th:7th:7th:6th:6th] row. 71 [75:79:79:83:87]sts.

Cont without shaping until Sleeve measures 43 [46: 46:47:47:48]cm, 17 [18:18:18½:18½:19]in, ending with a ws row.

## Shape Sleeve Top

Cast off 6sts at at beg of next 2 rows.

59 [63:67:67:71:75]sts.

Work 4 [6:6:6:6:8] rows dec 1 st at each end of every row. 51 [51:55:55:59:59]sts.

Work 22 [22:22:26:26:26] rows dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row. 29 [29:33:29:33:33]sts. Work 6 [6:8:6:8:8] rows dec 1 st at each end of every row. 17sts.

Cast off 4sts at each end of next 2 rows. 9sts.
Cast off rem 9sts.

## Short Sleeves (Both alike)

**Using 3mm (US2) needles** cast on 71 [75:79:79:83: 87]sts and work 8 rows in 1x1 rib.

Change to 3.75mm (US5) needles and working in st-st (throughout) cont until Sleeve measures 8 [8: 8:9:9:9]cm, 3 [3:3:3½:3½:3½]in, ending with a ws

## **Shape Sleeve Top**

Work as given for Shape Sleeve Top of Long Sleeves.

# Border

Join shoulder seams. With rs facing, using 3mm (US2) circular needle, commencing at lower edge of Right Front pick up and knit 22sts evenly along rib, 56sts evenly along straight edge to marker, 84 [84:87:89:92:95]sts evenly along shaped edge, 37 [37:37:39:39:39]sts from cast off sts at back of neck, 84 [84:87:89:92:95]sts evenly along shaped edge to marker, 56sts evenly along straight edge and 22sts evenly along rib.

361 [361:367:373:379:385]sts.

Next Row: Knit.

Commencing with 1st row of 1x1 rib work 3 rows. **Next Row:** Rib to last 77sts, cast off 2sts, (rib 15, cast off 2sts) 4 times, rib 2.

Next Row: Rib 3, cast on 2sts, (rib 16, cast on 2sts) 4 times, rib to end.
Work 3 rows in rib.
Cast off in rib.

# To Complete

Fold Sleeves in half lengthways then placing folds to shoulder seams sew Sleeves in position. Join side and Sleeve seams. Sew on buttons. See ball band for care instructions.
