





## NK-36 & NK-43

Noro Kureyon







HAT

SIZE: small (large)

MATERIALS

KUREYON: 100 grams color no. 22. Size 6 knitting needles, or circular needle (or size necessary to obtain correct gauge).


STITCHES USED

Stockinette St - St.St: Garter St: 1x1 Ribbing:

Pattern St: Rows 1 and 2: Knit. Rows 3 through 13: ST.St, (beg with knit row). Row 14: Knit.

GAUGE

In Pattern St, 18 sts and 28 rows = 4x4"



GAUGE

With larger needles in Pattern St, 18 sts and 28 rows = 4x4" INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 11 (12) sts; alternateing colors, cast on 7 groups of 10 (11) sts: 81 (89) sts. Work 1x1 Ribbing for 3 1/2" (4"), increasing 1 st on last row so that blocks at beg and end of row have 11 (12) sts. Beginning with row 3, work Pattern St 6 times. Maintaing color pattern, work 1 row Garter St and bind off. Sew side seam, turning Ribbing seam to right side of work.



NK-43

SCARF

SIZE: 7 1/4" x 48"

MATERIALS

KUREYON: 100 grams color no. 22. Size 5 knitting needles (or size necessary to obtain correct gauge).

STITCHES USED

Pattern St: Rows 1 and 2: Knit. Rows 3 through 19: ST.St, (beg with knit row). Row 20: Knit.

GAUGE

In Pattern St, 20 sts and 29 rows = 4x4"

INSTRUCTIONS

Wind colors into individual balls. Each block is 12 sts by 20 rows. Choosing 3 colors at random, cast on 12 sts of each color (36 sts). Keeping colors in separate lines, work 20 rows Pattern St. Change colors and continue in this same manner until Scarf is 16 blocks long. Purl 1 row; bind off.

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
