Col. No. Quantity x 100g Hanks

NEEDLES


1 pair 4.00mm needles (US 6)

1 pair 4.50mm needles (US 7)

TENSION/GAUGE

 $23 \ \mathrm{sts}$ and $25 \ \mathrm{rows}$ measured over 10 cm of Pattern using 4.50mm needles.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS 6 Buttons



TEXTURED CARDIGAN

Pattern (multi 4+3)

Row 1(RS) * P3, k1; rep from * to last 3 sts, p3.

Row 2 K3, * p1, k3; rep from * to end.

Row 3 * P1, k1, p2; rep from * to last 3 sts, p1, k1, p1.

Row 4 K1, p1, k1, * k2, p1, k1; rep from * to end.

These 4 rows form pattern repeat.

Pocket Linings (make 2)

Using 4.50mm needles, cast on 25 sts.

Work 12 cm in St st, ending on a RS row.

Leave sts on a holder.

Note This yarn is hand dyed to give it unique character, it is therefore advised to work from 2 hanks at a time as this will help blend the colours and avoid any inconsistencies.

BACK

Using 4.50mm needles, cast on 114(126,138) sts.

(RS) K2 * p2, k2; rep from * to end.

(WS) P2 * k2, p2; rep from * to end.

These 2 rows form rib.

Cont working in Rib, until length measures 6 cm, ending on a WS row, inc 1 st on last row worked. [115(127,139) sts]

Now cont working in patt rep until length (incl band) measures 66 cm, ending on a WS row.

Shape back neck (RS) Patt 50(55,60) sts, turn, leave rem sts on a holder. Work each side of neck separately.

(WS) Cast off 5 sts, patt to end.

(RS) Patt 1 row.

(WS) Cast off 5 sts, patt to end.

(RS) Cast off rem 40(45,50) sts.

With RS facing, rejoin to rem sts, cast off 15(17,19) centre sts, patt to end.

(WS) Patt 1 row.

(RS) Cast off 5 sts, patt to end.

(WS) Patt 1 row.

(RS) Cast off 5 sts, patt to end.

(WS) Cast off rem 40(45,50) sts.

LEFT FRONT

Using 4.50mm needles, cast on 52(60,68) sts.

(RS) * K2, p2; rep from * to end.

(WS) * K2, p2; rep from * to end.

These 2 rows form rib.

Cont working in rib until length measures 6 cm, ending on a WS row, inc 3 sts on last row worked. [55(63,71) sts]

Cont working in patt rep until length (incl band) measures 20 cm, ending on a WS row.

Place pocket (RS) Patt 15(19,23) sts, leave 25 sts on a holder, patt to end.

(WS) Patt 15(19,23) sts, patt across 25 sts of one pocket lining, patt to end.

[55(63,71) sts]

Cont working in patt rep until length (incl band) measures 60 cm, ending on a RS row.

Shape front neck (WS) Cast off 3(4,5) sts, patt to end

(RS) Patt 1 row.

(WS) Cast off 2 sts at beg next row, then beg foll alt rows, 5(6,7) times more.

[40(45,50) sts, 13(15,17) shaping rows] Cont working straight until length (incl band) measures same as back to shoulders, ending on a WS row.
(RS) Cast off rem 40(45,50) sts.

RIGHT FRONT

Work as for left front, reverse all shapings.

MAKING UP

Press pieces gently on WS, using a warm iron over a damp cloth. Join shoulder seams.

Armbands

Right armband Mark a position 18(19,20) cm from shoulder seam along front and same along back. With RS facing, using 4.50mm needles, pickup and knit 88(92,96) sts along edge between markers.

(WS) $\,^*$ K2, p2; rep from * to end.

(RS) $\,^{*}$ K2, p2; rep from * to end.

These 2 rows form rib.

Cont working in rib until length measures 6 cm, ending on a WS row.

(RS) Cast off in rib.

Repeat for left armband.

Neckband With RS facing, using 4.50mm needles, pickup and knit 25 sts along right side front neck, 44(48,52) sts along back neck and 25 sts along left side front neck. [94(98,102) sts]

(WS) P2 * k2, p2; rep from * to end.

(RS) K2 * p2, k2; rep from * to end.

These 2 rows form rib.

Cont working in rib until length measures 4 cm, ending on a WS row.

Cast off in rib.

Frontbands

Leftband (Buttonband) With RS facing, using 4.50mm needles, pickup and knit 138 sts along left front.

(WS) P2 * k2, p2; rep from * to end.

(RS) K2 * p2, k2; rep from * to end.

These 2 rows form rib. **

Cont working in rib until length measures 4 cm, ending on a WS row.

Cast off in rib.

Mark positions for 6 buttons, the first to be placed approx 2 cm from top of band, the last to be placed approx 2 cm from bottom of band, the other 4 to be spaced evenly between.

Rightband (Buttonhole band) Work as for Leftband to **

Work WS row once more.

Buttonhole row Rib 4 sts, * yf, k2tog, rib to next button placement; rep from * until 6 buttonholes are made, rib to end.

Cont working in rib until length measures 4 cm, ending on a WS row.

Cast off in rib.

Sew buttons to leftband.

Pockets

Sew pocket lining to inside.

With RS facing, pickup and knit 25 sts from holder of front pocket.

(WS) K1 * p2, k2; rep from * to end.

(RS) * P2, k2; rep from * to last st, p1.

Rep these 2 rows 3 times more then WS row once more.

Cast off in rib.

Repeat for rem pocket.

Sew ends of pockets to bodice.
