

# Cabled Jacket

#### Size

ONE SIZE To fit bust 34/38in (86/96cm)

# Finished Measurements

Width 60in/162cm (underarm)

Length 20in/51cm Sleeve Length 8in/20cm

## Materials

US 10½ (6½mm) needles (x2)

570 gr (about 6 skeins) Noro Cyochin shade #7

## Tension

Measured over stocking stitch using US  $10\frac{1}{2}$  needles 14sts x 22rs = 4in (10cm) square.

#### **TENSION**

**VERY IMPORTANT:** Wk a tension square, if too small use a larger needle, if too large use a smaller needle. It is essential to work to correct tension to achieve finished measurements stated.

#### ABBREVIATIONS (not all abbreviations apply to this pattern)

K = knit. NR = next row. P = purl. foll = following.

st(s) = stitch(es). st.st. = stocking stitch (RSF knit.

rs = rows. WSF purl

**wk** = work. **Rev.st.st.** = reverse stocking stitch

ins = inches. (RSF purl, WSF knit).
dec = decrease(ing). beg = beginning.

inc = increase(ing).

patt = pattern.

beg = beginning.

alt = alternate.

ch = chain.

with a make one suich thus: pick up norizontal loop lying between last stitch worked and next stitch and knit into back of loop.

T3F = slip next 2sts onto a cable needle and hold at front of work, purl next st from left hand needle then K2sts from cable needle.

T3B = Slip next stitch onto a cable needle and hold at back of work, knit next 2sts from left hand needle then Purl stitch from cable needle.

**C6F** (**C6B**) = slip next 3sts onto a cable needle and hold at front (back) of work, knit next 3sts from left hand needle then K3sts from cable needle.

C4B = slip next 2sts onto a cable needle and hold at back of work, knit next 2sts from left hand needle then K2sts from cable needle.

# Instructions

#### BACK

With US 101/2 needles cast on 113sts and wk as follows:

Row 1: (RSF) K1, \* P1, K1, rep from \* to end.

Row 2: K all K sts and P all P sts to end.

Rep the last 2 rs once more then row 1 once again.

NR: Foundation row: (WSF) \* K4, [K1, P1] 5 times, \* rep \* to \* 7 times more, K1 Wk patt as follows:

Row 1: (RSF) P1, \* [K1 below, P1] 5 times, P4\* rep \* to \* 7 times more.

Row 2: \* K4, [K1 below, P1] 5 times, \* rep \* to \* 7 times more, K1.

Now 2. " K4, [K1 below, F1] 5 littles, " lep " to " 1 littles filote, K1.

Rep the last 2rs 7 times more.

Row 17: (RSF) P1, \*P1, [P2tog] 4 times, [K1, M1P] 4 times, K1, \* rep \* to \* 7 times more.

Row 18: \* [P1, K1 below] 5 times, K4, \* rep \* to \* 7 times more, K1.

Row 19: P1, \* P4, [P1, K1below] 5 times, \* rep \* to \* 7 times more.

Row 20: As row 18.

Rep the last 2 rs 6 times more. (32rs)

Row 33: P1, \* [K1, M1P] 4 times, K1, P1, [P2tog] 4 times, \* rep \* to \* 7 times more.

Row 34: \* K4, [K1 below, P1] 5 times, \* rep \* to \* 7 times more, K1.

Row 35: P1, \* [K1 below, P1] 5 times, P4\* rep \* to \* 7 times more.

Row 36: As row 34.

Rep the last 2 rs 6 times more. (48rs)

Rep patt from row 17 for a further 80rs.

Cast off

Place a colored marker at each end of row 99 of main patt.

This indicates armhole.

#### **FRONT**

Make exactly as given for back.

#### *SLEEVES*

Join shoulder seams along 37sts on the cast off rows.

RSF with US 10½ needles pick up and K43sts evenly between colored markers. Wk as follows:

Row 1: Kl, \* Pl, Kl, rep from \* to end.

Row 2: K all K sts and P all P sts to end.

Rep the last 2 rs AT THE SAME TIME dec 1 st at each end the 5th row and every foll 6th row until 31sts rem.

Wk straight until sleeve measures 8 ins from pick up row.

Cast off.

#### *MAKEUP*

Sew up side and sleeve seams
