Whitsunday knit/crochet berets

size

Adult Medium

materials

for knitted beret

100g of Queensland Collection's *Whitsunday* shade #3 Green Size US 7 (4.5mm) knitting needles Size US 10 (6mm) knitting needles

gauge

16 sts per 4in (10cm)

abbreviations

k knit

k2tog knit 2 stitches together knitwise

M1 make one new stitch

p purl

p2tog purl 2 stitches together

rnd round
st(s) stitch(es)

instructions

KNITTED BERET

Ribbing

On US 7, cast on 80 sts

Rnds 1-10: k2 p2 all the way around for 10 rnds

Rnd 11: knit one rnd

Body

Switch to US 10

Rnd 12-13: purl 2 rnds

Switch to US 7

Rnd 14: (k4, m1)* repeat around

Rnd 15: knit 1 rnd

Rnd 16: (k5, m1)* repeat around

Rnd 17-18: knit 2 rnds

Rnd 19-21: with US 10, purl 3 rnds with US 7, knit 5 rnds with US 7, knit 5 rnds with US 10, purl 4 rnds with US 7, knit 5 rnds

Crown Decreases

Switch to US 10

Rnd 35: (p4, p2tog)* repeat around (p3, p2tog)* repeat around

Rnd 37: purl 1 rnd

Switch to US 7

Rnd 38: (knit 8, k2tog)* repeat around Rnd 39: (knit 7, k2tog)* repeat around Rnd 40: (knit 6, k2tog)* repeat around Rnd 41: (knit 5, k2tog)* repeat around Rnd 42: (knit 4, k2tog)* repeat around

Switch to US 10

Rnd 43: (purl 3, p2tog)* repeat around Rnd 44: (purl 2, p2tog)* repeat around

Switch to US 7

Rnd 45: (knit 1, k2tog)* repeat around **Rnd 46:** K2tog all the way around

Finishing

With darning needle, thread yarn through all remaining stitches and back through first two stitches. Weave into inside of hat. Weave in all tails securely. Q

blo back loop only

ch chain

dc double crochet

dcblo double crochet in the back loop only

dcdec double crochet decrease ([yo, pull up a loop from

next stitch, yo pull through two]x2, yo, pull through

all three loops)

rnd round

sc single crochet

scblo single crochet in the back loop only

sl st slip stitch st(s) stitch(es) yo yarn over

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instructions

CROCHETED BERET

- **Row 1:** Chain 4, dc11 in third Ch from hook, sl st to join
- Row 2: 2dc in each dc around, sl st to join rnd
- **Row 3:** Ch1, *scblo, 2 scblo in next st* repeat around, sl st to join rnd
- **Row 4:** Ch1, *scblo in next 2sts, 2 scblo in next st* repeat around, sl st to join rnd
- **Row 5:** Ch3, *dc in next 3sts, 2 dc in next st*repeat around, sl st to join
- **Row 6:** Ch3, *dc in next 4sts, 2 dc in next st*repeat around, sl st to join
- **Row 7:** Ch1, *scblo in next 5sts, 2 scblo in next st* repeat around, sl st to join rnd
- **Row 8:** Ch1, *scblo in next 6sts, 2 scblo in next st* repeat around, sl st to join rnd
- **Row 9:** Ch1, scblo in next 7sts, 2 scblo in next st* repeat around, sl st to join rnd
- **Row 10:** Ch3, *dc in next 8sts, 2 dc in next st*repeat around, sl st to join
- Row 11: Ch3, dc in every st
- Row 12: Ch3, dc in every st
- Row 13: Ch3, Dcdec all the way around
- **Row 14:** Ch3, dc loosely in each st all the way around, sl st to join rnd
- **Row 15:** Ch3, dc loosely in each st all the way around, sl st to join rnd
- **Row 16:** Ch3, dc loosely in each st all the way around, sl st to join rnd
- Row 17: Ch1, Scblo around, sl st to join rnd
- Row 18: Ch1, Scblo around, sl st to join rnd
- Row 19: Ch1, Scblo around, sl st to join rnd
- Row 20: Ch3, dcblo in each stitch around, sl st to join rnd
- **Row 21:** With yarn doubled, sc in every st around, sl st to join, cut yarn and weave in ends securely. Q
