

- 1. The best results occur when reservations are required.
- 2. Don't be afraid to charge a nominal admission fee to defray your costs.
- 3. Refreshments need not be extravagant but enhance the event.
- 4. Be sure to prepare a "program" listing all yarn details, including price.
 - 5. It is helpful to have swatches worked up in advance.
 - 6. How organized you wish to be is your choice. Some shops go all out by setting
 - up individual "place settings" of yarn or by preparing yarn packets for each attendee. Others simply put out all the yarns with a pair of scissors and everyone has a go at it.
 - 7. If you do not have assistance, it is best to host the event when the shop is closed.
 - 8. Be prepared to suggest appropriate patterns for your chosen yarns.
 - 9. Consider a theme, such as Luxurious Fibers, Multi-colors, Single color, Specific Gauge, etc.
 - 10. Advertise your event with enough lead time.
