# MISINA COAT & LEGWARMERS

## SIZE

Italian size 44 = US size 10 (approx. Medium).

# MATERIALS

- 18 50g balls of Lana Gatto *MISINA* shade #4003 Grey [15 balls for coat and 3 balls for legwarmers.]
- One pair size US 6 (4 mm) needles or size to obtain gauge.
- One pair size US 9 (5.5mm) needles or size to obtain gauge.
- Size D-3 (3.25 mm) crochet hook.
- Tapestry needle with rounded point.
- 5 buttons.

# **STITCHES**

## **USING KNITTING NEEDLES:**

## Tubular stitch (work on even number of sts)

Row 1: k2, \* wyif, slip 1 st purlwise, wyib, k1, rep from \* to end.

**Row 2:** wyif, slip 1 st purlwise, \* k1, wyif, slip 1 st purlwise, wyib, rep from \* to last st, k1. Rep rows 1-2 for Tubular st.

## Stockinette stitch

## **Reverse Stockinette stitch**

## 2x2 Rib (multiple of 4 sts plus 2)

Row 1: \* k2, p2; rep from \* to last 2 sts, k2. Row 2: k the knit sts and p the purl sts. Rep Row 2 for 2x2 Rib.

## Rib A (on multiple of 7 sts plus 2)

Row 1 (RS): \* p2, M1, k1, p3tog, k1, M1; rep from \* to last 2 sts, p2. Row 2: k2, \* p5, k2 ; rep from \* to end.

Rep rows 1-2 for Rib A.

## Rib B (on multiple of 6 sts plus 1)

**Row 1 (WS):** k1, \* p5, k1; rep from \* to end. **Row 2:** \* p1, M1, k1, p3tog, k1, M1 ; rep from \* to last st, p1. Rep rows 1-2 for Rib B.

## Fancy Stitch (on multiple of 4 sts plus 3)

Row 1: \* p3, k1; rep from \* to last 3 sts, p3.
Row 2: k the knit sts and p the purl sts.
Row 3: \* p1, k1, p2 ; rep from \* to last 3 sts, p1, k1 and p1.
Row 4: k the knit sts and p the purl sts.
Rep. Rows 1-4 for Fancy Rib.

# USING CROCHET HOOK:

## Chain stitch

Slip stitch

Single crochet

## Reverse single crochet (rev sc)

Insert hook in next st, working from left to right, yo, pull up a loop (lp), yo, pull through 2 lps on hook.

## USING TAPESTRY NEEDLE:

## **Darning stitch**

# GAUGE

19 sts and 22 rows to 4in/10cm over Rib A and B using size US 9 (5.5mm) needles.

21 sts and 22 rows to 4in/10cm over Fancy st using size US 9 (5.5mm) needles.

# ВАСК

Using larger needles cast on 100 sts. Work 4 rows in Tubular st. Cont in Rib A. When piece measures 15<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>in/39cm from beg, dec 15 sts evenly distributed and cont in Rib B. When piece measures 24in/61cm from beg, shape armhole binding off 3 sts at beg of

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next 2 rows. Work first and last 3 sts in Stockinette st. On next row (RS) dec 2 sts each side inside 2 sts from edge, then dec 1 st each side every other row inside 2 sts from edge twice.

Work even until armhole measures 7<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>in/19cm. Bind off rem 71 sts.

# LEFT FRONT

Using larger needles cast on 50 sts. Work 4 rows in Tubular st. Cont in Rib A. When piece measures  $15^{1/4}$ in/39cm from beg, dec 6 sts evenly distributed and cont in Rib B, working 1 selvedge st on opening edge (left side on RS rows). When piece measures 24in/61cm from beg, shape armhole binding off 3 sts at beg of next RS row. Work first 3 sts in Stockinette st. On next row (RS) dec 2 sts inside 2 sts from armhole edge, then dec 1 st same side every other row inside 2 sts from armhole edge twice. Cont even until armhole measures  $2^{1/4}$ in/6cm, ending with a RS row. On next row (WS) shape neck binding off first 16 sts.

Work even until neck shaping measures  $5^{1/4}$ in/13cm. Bind off rem 21 sts for shoulder.

# **RIGHT FRONT**

Work to correspond to Left Front, reversing all shaping.

## **SLEEVES (MAKE 2)**

Using smaller needles cast on 42 sts. Work 4 rows in Tubular st and 14 rows in 2x2 Rib for cuff (approx 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>in/6,5cm). Change to larger needles. Inc 4 sts evenly distributed on next row (there are 46 sts), work as follows: 5 sts in Stockinette st, 3 sts in Reverse Stockinette st, 6 sts in Stockinette st, 1 st in Reverse Stockinette st, 16 sts in Rib A, 1 st in Reverse Stockinette st, 6 sts in Stockinette st, 3 sts in Reverse Stockinette st, 5 sts in Stockinette st. Cont as established until piece measures 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>in/4cm from cuff. Inc 1 st each side on next and every 8th row 6 more times, working inc sts in Stockinette st. There are 60 sts. When sleeve measures 13<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>in/35cm from cuff, shape cap binding off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows, then dec each side, inside 2 sts from edge, 1 st every other row 4 times, every 4th row 5 times, 2 sts every other row 6 times. When sleeve cap measures 7<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>in/19cm, bind off rem 12 sts.

# POCKETS (MAKE 2)

Using larger needles cast on 30 sts. Work in 2x2 Rib until pocket measures 5in/13cm. Change to smaller needles and work 2 rows in Tubular st and 5 rows in Stockinette st. Bind off all sts on WS. Using crochet hook work a sc row along upper edge. Cut off yarn and weave ends.

# **FINISHING**

Sew shoulder seams. Using smaller needles with RS pick up and k 100 sts along opening edge of Left Front. Work Border as follows: k next row (WS), 6 rows in 2x2 Rib and 4 rows in Tubular st. Bind off in Darning st using tapestry needle. Work Border along Right Front opening to correspond Left Border. Make 6 buttonholes along 5th row in 2x2 Rib at regular distance. For each buttonhole bind off 2 sts and on next row cast on 2 corresponding sts over them. Using crochet hook work a sc row along neck edge with right side facing: work 6 sts along Right opening edge, 76 sts along Front and Back neck shaping, 6 sts along Left opening edge. Cut off and weave ends. Collar: Using smaller needles with RS pick up and k center 74 sts of crochet row, work 1 row k on WS and 18 rows in 2x2 Rib. Leave these 74 sts on a spare needle. For Collar edging, using smaller needles pick up and k 18 sts along right vertical side, rib the 74 sts, pick up and k 18 sts along left vertical side. There are 110 sts. Work 4 rows in Tubular st. Bind off all sts in Darning st with tapestry needle. Using crochet hook, work a row in Reverse single crochet on 6 sc at top of each opening border. Set in sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams. Sew a pocket on each Front. Sew buttons on Left opening Border to correspond to buttonholes.


## **LEG-WARMERS (MAKE 2)**

With smaller needles cast on 50 sts. Work 4 rows in Tubular st and 6 rows in 2x2 Rib for Lower Border. Change to larger needles and work in Fancy st, inc 1 st on next row. There are 51 sts. Work even until piece measures 13in/33cm from Lower Border. Change to smaller needles and, for Upper Border, dec 1 st on next row and work 6 rows in 2x2 Rib and 4 rows in Tubular st. Bind off in Darning st with tapestry needle rem 50 sts. Sew side seam

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
