SHORT-SLEEVED PULLOVER

## romerto



## SIZE

Italian size 44 = US size 10 (approx. Medium).

## MATERIALS

- 850 g balls of Lana Gatto MISINA shade \#12959 Teal.
- One pair size US $6(4 \mathrm{~mm}$ ) needles or size to obtain gauge.
- One pair size US $9(5.5 \mathrm{~mm})$ needles or size to obtain gauge.
- Cable needle.
- Stitch-holders.
- Tapestry needle with rounded point.


## STITCHES

## USING KNITTING NEEDLES:

## Tubular stitch (work on odd number of sts)

Row 1: k1, * wyif, slip 1 st purlwise, wyib, k1, rep from * to end.
Row 2: wyif, slip 1 st purlwise, * k1, wyif, slip 1 st purlwise, wyib, rep from * to end.
Rep rows 1-2 for Tubular st.

## Stockinette stitch

## Reverse Stockinette stitch

## $3 \times 3$ Rib (multiple of 6 sts plus 3 )

Row 1: * k3, p3; rep from * to last 3 sts, k3.
Row 2: $k$ the knit sts and $p$ the purl sts.
Rep Row 2 for $3 \times 3$ Rib.
Large Cable (worked on 30 sts)
Row 1 (RS): p3, k 24, p3.
Row 2 and all even rows: $k$ the knit sts and $p$ the purl sts.
Row 3: p3, 12 right crossed sts (slip 6 sts to cable needle and hold to back of work, k 6 sts, k 6 sts from cable needle), 12 left crossed sts (slip 6 sts to cable needle and hold to front of work, k 6 sts, k 6 sts from cable needle), p3.
Rows 5, 7 and 9: rep Row 1.
Row 10: $k$ the knit sts and $p$ the purl sts.
Rep 1-10 rows.
USING TAPESTRY NEEDLE:
Darning stitch

## GAUGE

16 sts and 21 rows to $4 \mathrm{in} / 10 \mathrm{~cm}$ over Stockinette st and Reverse Stockinette st using size US 9 ( 5.5 mm ) needles.

Large Cable ( 30 sts ) measures $43 / 4 \mathrm{in} / 12 \mathrm{~cm}$.

Using smaller needles cast on 81 sts. Work rows in Tubular st and 6 rows in $3 \times 3$ Rib. Change to larger needles and work as follows: 15 sts in Stockinette st, 3 sts in Reverse Stockinette st, ( 9 sts in Stockinette st, 3 sts in Reverse Stockinette st) 4 times, 15 sts in Stockinette st.
When Back measures $161 / 2 \mathrm{in} / 42 \mathrm{~cm}$ from beg, shape armholes. Bind off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows, dec 2 sts each side every other RS row inside 4 sts from edge (work sssk at beg of row slip 3 sts separately to right needle as if to knit, slip left needle into these 3 sts from left to right and knit them tog: 3 sts become 1 st - and work k3tog at end of row) twice. Then dec 1 st each side every 4 th row inside 3 sts from edge (work ssk at beg of row - slip 2 sts separately to right needle as if to knit, slip left needle into these 2 sts from left to right and knit them tog: 2 sts become 1 st - and work k2tog at end of row) 7 times. AT THE SAME TIME, when armhole measures $3 \mathrm{in} / 7,5 \mathrm{~cm}$, begin to work center 55 sts in Reverse Stockinette st. When armhole measures $73 / 4 \mathrm{in} / 19.5 \mathrm{~cm}$, shape neck.
Next row (RS): work 16 sts, join a 2nd ball of yarn, bind off center 21 sts, work to end.
Working both sides at once, bind off 2 sts from each neck edge. When neck shaping measures $3 / 4 \mathrm{in} / 2 \mathrm{~cm}$, bind off rem 14 sts each shoulder.

## FRONT

Using smaller needles cast on 81 sts. Work rows in Tubular st and 6 rows in $3 \times 3$ Rib. Change to larger needles and work as follows: work first 15 sts in Stockinette st, work next 21 sts inc 9 sts evenly distributed -there are 30 sts for Large Cable-, work next 9 sts inc 3 sts evenly distributed -there are 12 sts for Stockinette st-, work next 21 sts inc 9 sts evenly distributed there are 30 sts for Large Cable-, work last 15 sts in Stockinette st. There are 102 sts. When Front measures $161 / 2 \mathrm{in} / 42 \mathrm{~cm}$ from beg, shape armholes. Bind off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows, dec 2 sts each side every other RS row inside 4 sts from edge twice, then dec 1 st each side every 4th row inside 3 sts from edge 5 times. AT THE SAME TIME, when armhole measures $3 \mathrm{in} / 7.5 \mathrm{~cm}$, dec 21 sts evenly distributed on next row and begin to work center 55 sts in Reverse Stockinette st. When armhole measures $61 / 2 \mathrm{in} / 16.5 \mathrm{~cm}$, shape neck.
Next row (RS): work 24 sts, join a 2nd ball of yarn, bind off center 17 sts, work to end. Working both sides at once, bind off 2 sts from each neck edge twice, dec 1 st every other row. When neck shaping measures $2 \mathrm{in} / 5 \mathrm{~cm}$, bind off rem 14 sts each shoulder.

## FINISHING

Sew right shoulder seam. Using larger needles, with RS facing pick up and k 80 sts all around Front and Back neck-edge. Work 13 rows in Reverse Stockinette st, (3 rows in Stockinette st, 7 rows in Reverse Stockinette st) twice, 3 rows in Stockinette st. On next row dec 5 sts evenly distributed and work 7 rows in Reverse Stockinette st. Cast off all sts. Sew left shoulder and collar seam (the collar will be turned in half). For Right SleeveCap, using larger needles, with RS facing pick up and k63 all along Right armhole starting and ending $1 \mathrm{in} / 3 \mathrm{~cm}$ from boundoff sts. Work in Stockinette st, leaving 3 sts on stitch-holders at beg of next 16 sts ( 24 sts on each side). Using smaller needles, work over all sts 4 rows in $3 \times 3$ Rib and
4 rows in Tubular st. Bind off in Darning st with tapestry needle. For Left Sleeve-Cap, using larger needles, with RS facing pick up and k63 all along Left armhole and work as Right Sleeve-Cap. Sew side seams
