




TOLLEGNO DAL 1900 FEELING CROPPED JACKET



# FEELING OPPED JACKET

### SIZE

Italian size 44 = US size 10 (approx. Medium).

### MATERIALS

- 5 50g balls of Lana Gatto FEELING shade #12504 Grey.
- One pair size US 4 (3.5mm) needles or size to obtain gauge.
- One pair size US 6 (4mm) needles or size to obtain gauge.
- Tapestry needle with rounded point.
- Two <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>in/2cm buttons.

# **STITCHES**

#### USING KNITTING NEEDLES:

#### Tubular stitch (work on even number of sts):

Row 1: k2, \* wyif, sl 1 st purlwise, wyib, k1, rep from \* to end. Row 2: wyif, sl 1 st purlwise, \* k1, wyif, sl 1 st purlwise, wyib, rep from \* to last st, k1. Rep these 2 rows.

#### Garter stitch

Stockinette stitch

#### **Reverse Stockinette stitch**

2x2 Rib

Flower Pattern (over a multiple of 4 sts plus 2):

Row 1 (RS): k all sts.

Row 2: p all sts.

Rows 3 and 4: work in Garter st.

Row 5: k1, \*k1 wrapping yarn 3 times around needle; rep from \* to last st, k1.

Row 6: k 1, \*yarn back, sl next 4 sts to right needle as if to purl them, dropping extra wraps, sl these 4 sts from right needle to left needle, insert right needle into these 4 sts tog for working k1, p1, k1, p1; rep from \* to last st, k1.

There are flowers made by 4 sts each, plus selvedge st each side. Rows 7 and 8: work in Garter st.

Rep Rows 1-8 for Flower Patt.

#### **USING TAPESTRY NEEDLE:**

#### Darning stitch

# GAUGE

20 sts and 26 rows to 4in/10cm over Flower patt, using size US 4 (3.5mm) needles.

# ABBREVIATIONS

# BACK

With smaller needles cast on 82 sts. Work 4 rows in Tubular st and 6 rows in Garter st. Cont even in Flower patt until piece measures 15<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>in/40cm from beg. Bind off all sts.

## LEFT FRONT

With smaller needles cast on 30 sts. Work 4 rows in Tubular st and 6 rows in Garter st. Then work in Flower patt, inc 1 st at end of next RS row (1 st in from opening edge) and every other row at same edge 7 more times. There are 38 sts. Cont even in Flower patt until piece measures 13in/33cm from beg, ending with a RS row. Shape neck.

Next row (WS): Bind off 4 sts (neck edge) work to end. Cont to bind off 4 sts from neck edge once, then bind off 2 sts from neck edge 4 times. Work until piece measures same as for Back. Bind off rem 22 sts for shoulder.


# **RIGHT FRONT**

Work to correspond to Left Front, reversing all shaping.

## **SLEEVES (MAKE 2)**

Work top down. With smaller needles cast on 74 sts and work 4 rows in Garter st. Cont to work in Flower patt until piece measures 91/2in/23cm from beg. Work 8 rows in Tubular st. Bind off all sts with tapestry needle in Darning st.

# POCKETS (MAKE 2)

With larger needles and 2 strands of yarn held tog, cast on 19 sts. Work 2 rows in Garter st and 15 rows in Stockinette st, ending with a RS row.

**Next row (WS):** p2, \* p2 tog (1 dec made), p1; rep from \* 4 more times, p2. 14 sts remain. Work 4 rows in reverse Stockinette st. Bind off all sts.

## NECK AND OPENING EDGE

#### Sew shouder seams.

*For Left Edge*, with smaller needles starting from center of Back neck edge pick up and k 117 sts evenly along neck edge and down Left Front opening. Pay attention to keep work flat (for this, pick up 3 sts on upper and lower Front corner). Work 3 rows in Garter st and 2 rows in Tubular st. Bind off all sts with tapestry needle in Darning st.

*For Right Edge,* with smaller needles starting from lower edge of Right Front opening pick up and k 117 sts evenly up Right Front and along neck edge until to half Back (as made for Left Edge). Work 2 rows in Garter st.


**Next row (RS):** k, working a buttonhole (yo, k2 tog) 4in/10cm from beg of row and another buttonhole  $3\frac{1}{2}in/8cm$  from previous.

Work last 2 rows in Tubular st. Bind off all sts with tapestry needle in Darning st. Join Left and Right Edge seam at half Back.

## **FINISHING**

With center of cast-on sleeve sts at shoulder seam, sew top of sleeve to Front and Back .

Sew side and sleeve seams. Sew Pockets on Fronts  $3\frac{1}{2}in/8cm$  from lower edge and  $1\frac{1}{2}in/4cm$  from side seam. Sew 2 button on Left Front to correspond buttonholes



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
