



FEELING ASYMMETRICAL CAPE & CAP



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SIZE

Italian size 44 = US size 10 (approx. Medium).

MATERIALS

- 32 50g balls of Lana Gatto *FEELING* shade #12982 Charcoal (30 balls for cape and 2 balls for cap.)
- One pair size US 19 (16mm) needles or size to obtain gauge.
- Cable needle.
- Size G-6 (4mm) crochet hook.
- Size K-10¹/₂ (6.5mm) crochet hook.
- Sewing needle.
- Scrap yarn in black for cape.
- Round buckle.

STITCHES

USING KNITTING NEEDLES:

Stockinette stitch

Reverse Stockinette stitch

3x3 Rib (work on a multiple of 6 sts plus 3 sts) Row 1 (RS): k3, * p3, k3; rep from * to end.

Row 2 and all even rows: k the knit sts and p the purl sts.

Lace Cable pattern (work on a multiple of 12 sts plus 10) Row 1 (RS): (p2, k6, p2, k2 tog, yo) twice, p2, k6, p2.

Row 2 and other WS rows: (k2, p6, k4)twice, k2, p6, k2.

Row 3: *p2, k6, p2, yo, ssk (= sl 2 stitches separately to right needle as if to knit, sl left needle into these 2 sts from left to right and knit them together- 2 sts become 1) * rep from * once more, p2, k6, p2.

Row 5: * p2, k6 left crossed sts (sl 3 sts to cable needle and hold to front of work, k 3 sts, k 3 sts from cable needle), p2, k2 tog, yo; rep from * once more, p2, k6 left crossed sts, p2.

Row 7: as Row 3.

Row 9: as Row 1.

Row 11: as Row 3.

Row 13: as Row 1.

Row 15: (p2, k6 left crossed sts, p2, yo, ssk) twice, p2, k6 left crossed sts, p2.

Row 17: as Row 1.

Row 19: as Row 3.

Row 20: as Row 2.

Rep Rows 1-20 throughout.

USING CROCHET HOOK:

Chain stitch [ch] Slip stitch [sl st] Half double crochet [hdc] Double crochet [dc] Single crochet [sc]

Reverse single crochet [rev sc]: Insert hook in next st, working from left to right, yo, pull up a lp, yo, pull through 2 lps on hook.

GAUGE

10 sts and 12 rows to 4in/10cm over Lace Cable patt, with 4 strands of yarn held tog, using size US 19 (16mm) needles.

20 sts and 22 rows to 4in/10cm over Half double crochet, with 2 strands of yarn held tog, using size K- $10\frac{1}{2}$ (6.5mm) crochet hook.

CAPE

Work in one piece. With size US 19 (16mm) needles and 4 strands of yarn held tog cast on 82 sts. Work in Lace Cable patt. When piece measures 16in/40cm from beg, shape neck dec only at one side 1 st every row 8 times, work 8 rows even, then at same side inc 1 st every row 8 times. Work even 7in/18cm more. Shape sleeve opening. Bind off center 18 sts and cast on 18 sts on next row, above bound off sts. Work even 7in/18cm more. Shape neck at same side, as previous shaping, dec 1 st every row 8 times, work 8 rows even, then at same side inc 1 st every row 8 times. Work even 16in/40cm more. Bind off the 82 sts.

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COWL

With size US 19 (16mm) needles and 4 strands of yarn held tog cast on 15 sts. Work in 3x3 Rib until piece measures 12in/30cm from beg. Bind off all sts.

FINISHING

Fold Cape in half along sleeve opening to divide Back and Front. Sew shoulder seams. Sew cowl seam, then join cowl around neck edge. With size G-6 (4mm) crochet hook and 2 strands of yarn held tog work in rev sc all around sleeve opening. Cut off and weave in ends. With size G-6 (4mm) crochet hook and black yarn cover buckle working all around in sc, inserting hook into buckle center for every stitch.

CAP

INSIDE PIECE

With size G-6 (4mm) crochet hook and 2 strands of yarn held tog, ch 2, join into ring with a sl st to first st. Into ring work 1 sl st, ch 2 (counts as first hdc) and 6 half dc. Join with a sl st to 2nd of beg 2 ch.

Next round: 2 ch (count as first hdc), 1 hdc into same st as last sl st, 2 hdc into each of next 6 sts.

Join with a sl st to 2nd of beg ch2. Cont to work hdc rounds inc some sts evenly distributed on each round to form a flat circle and to obtain 92 sts at end of Round 13.

Work 2 more rounds without inc, then work other 20 rounds inc only 1 st on every round, alternating inc placement, to obtain dome shape. There are 112 sts. Work 2 more rounds without inc. Cut off yarn and weave in ends.

OUTSIDE PIECE (IN MESH PATT)

With K-10 $\frac{1}{2}$ (6.5mm) crochet hook and 4 strands of yarn held tog, ch 4, join into ring with a sl st to first st.

Round 1: into ring work 1 sc, (ch 5, 1 sc) 3 times, end with ch 3 and 1 half dc into first sc (counts as last ch5 arch).

Round 2: 1 sc into first arch just formed, ch 5, I sc into same arch (an arch increased), * ch 5, 1sc into next arch; rep from * ending with ch 3 and 1 half dc into first sc (counts as last ch5 arch).

Rounds 3-7: work as Round 2, increasing a few arches to obtain 8 arches at end of Round 7.

Rounds 8-9: 1 sc into first arch just formed, * ch 6, 1sc into next arch; rep from * ending with ch 3 and 1 dc into first sc (counts as last ch6 arch).

Cut off yarn leaving a long tail. Use tail of the yarn to sew inside piece over inside piece.

EYESHADE AND BORDER

With K-10¹/₂ (6.5mm) crochet hook and 4 strands of yarn held tog, join yarn on RS and work 25 sc along last round of 2 joined pieces, in correspondence with 4 arches of Outside piece. Work each sc inserting hook into both pieces. Turn and work other 6 sc rows, dec 1 st each side every row. Then, on RS, work in reverse sc all around: into sts of last row, along a diagonal side of Eyeshade just made, along remaining edge of Cap and other diagonal side of Eyeshade. When work Border along Cap edge, work each sc inserting hook into both pieces (Inside and Outside pieces of Cap). Cut of yarn and weave in ends

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
