OUTLANDER CAPELET



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ABOUT

Based on the international bestselling novels by Diana Gabaldon, the Outlander television series shows our beleaguered heroine, Claire, frequently cavorting about the Scottish Highlands in rustic hand-knit accessories. This reproduction capelet appears to be one of her favorites. Worked on US size 17 needles, it's a snap to knit up while binge-watching a couple of episodes.

SIZE

One size.

MATERIALS

- 4 50g balls of Lana Gatto **WENGEN** shade #7190 Tan/Violet.
- One pair size US 17 (12 mm) needles or size to obtain gauge.
- Size L-11 (8 mm) crochet hook.

GAUGE

8 sts to 4in/10cm over Stockinette stitch using size US 17 (12mm) needles.

ABBREVIATIONS

cm	centimeters	mm	millimeters
g	grams	p	purl
in	inch[es]	rep	repeat
k	knit	ssk	skip, skip, knit
k2tog	knit next two stitches together	st[s]	stitch[es]
		yo	yarn over

CREDITS

CAPELET

Cast on 73 sts.

Moss st row: (k1, p1) across row.

Repeat this row for 3in.

Next row: k5, ssk, k to last 7 sts, k2tog, k5.

Next row: k5, p to last 5 sts, k5.

Repeat these two rows 8 times. 55 sts.

Eyelet row: k5, *(yo, k2tog, k3), rep from * 9 times, end k5.

Next row: k5, p to last 5 sts, k5.

Next row: knit

Next row: k5, p to last 5 sts, k5.

Resume Moss st row: (k1, p1) across row.

Repeat this row for 3in.

Bind off loosely. Weave in ends.

FINISHING

TIE

Using crochet hook, crochet a chain at least 40in in length. Knot ends. Weave tie through eyelet row
