TENZING

A bias-knit scarf that mimics the Tunisian crochet Berzelius pattern, Norgay is worked the long way to limit fiddly color changes and eliminates the need to pick up stitches. There is only one color change each row, which makes it a great introduction to intarsia. Although shown using all 14 colors, Norgay can be made with any number of colors, including just one, as texture creates an interesting pattern seen on either side of the scarf.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: Approx. 60" / 152.5 cm

Width: Approx. 6 1/4" / 16 cm

YARN

1 ball Juniper Moon Farm Tenzing in each of the foll colors:

#01 Rhone Night	#08 Scarlet
#02 Sage	#09 Alfalfa
#03 Gingersnap	#10 Fall Harvest
#04 Nimbus	#11 Burlywood
#05 Arctic River Blue	#12 Espresso
#06 Mystic Purple	#13 Thistle
#07 Crimson	#14 Seafoam

NEEDLES

US 3 (3.25 mm) long circular needle for knitting in the round, or size used to obtain gauge

NOTIONS

Tapestry needle

GAUGE:

25 sts and 32 rows = 4" / 10 cm in patt.

ABBREVIATIONS

approx.	approximately	M1R	make one right-leaning increase
beg	begin[ning]	p	purl
BO	bind off	patt	pattern
CO	cast on	rep	repeat[ing]
foll	follow[s][ing]	st[s]	stitch[es]

k2tog	knit two together		



First Strip

Using #07 and a knit CO, CO 175 sts, followed by 200 sts in #13.

Row 1: K1, M1R, k to 3 sts before the color change, k2tog, k1, change color with yarn in back (always lifting the new color from underneath the current), k1, M1R, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.

Row 2: *P1, k1; rep from * to color change, change color with yarn in front (always lifting the new color from underneath the current), *p1, k1; rep from * to end, ending with a p1.

Row 3: K1, M1R, k to 4 sts before the color change, k2tog, k2, change color with yarn in back (always lifting the new color from underneath the current), k1, M1R, k to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2.

Row 4: Rep row 2.

Rows 5 – 7: Rep Row 1-3.

Even Strips

Row 1: Change to color # 12, K1, M1R, k171, k2tog, k1, change to color #02 with yarn in back, k1, M1R, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.

Rows 2 – 7: Follow instructions as for First Strip.

Odd Strips

Row 1: Change to color # 01, K1, M1R, k196, k2tog, k1, change to color #03 with yarn in back (always lifting the new color from underneath the current), k1, M1R, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.

Rows 2 – 7: Follow instructions as for First Strip.

Rep Even and Odd Strips, using the foll color combinations for each strip:

Strip 4

First color: #09 Second color: #10

Strip 5

First color: #06 Second color: #04

Strip 6

First color: #08 Second color: #11

Strip 7**

First color: #05 Second color: #14

**For final strip, end with row 6 and then BO using a knit BO.

FINISHING

Weave in the ends. Wet block to measurements, taking care to pin out the edges to accentuate the points.
