









MEASUREMENTS: 50 3/8" (128 cm) long x 44 1/8" (112 cm) wide at the upper part, approx.

MATERIALS

INFINITY SHAWL: 1 ball col. 304 **Knitting needles:** size 8(U.S.)/(5 mm)

Stitches

Accordion st: see graph A

GAUGE

Graph A

Using size 8 needles in accordion st: 17 sts & 26 rows = 4x4.


INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 3 sts. Work in accordion st following graph A until the end of the ball of yarn then loosely

bind (cast off) all the sts.

releasing the st from the LH needle work another knit st by inserting the RH needle through the back of the st,

release st. /



MEASUREMENTS: 20 1/2" (52 cm) high, measuring at the centre, x 61" (155 cm) wide at the upper part, approximately

MATERIALS

INFINITY SHAWL: 1 ball col. 301 **Knitting needles:** size 6 (U.S.)/(4 mm)

Stitches

Garter st: work all the sts and all the rows in knit st **1x1 Ribbing: 1**st **row:** K1, P1. **2**nd **row:** work all sts as

they present themselves.

Pattern st 1, 2 & 3: see graphs A, B & C Increase: pick up the horizontal bar of yarn that lies between the st just worked and the next st to be worked, slip it onto the LH needle and K1 through the back of the st

GAUGE

Using size 6 needles in pattern st 1 & 2: 21 sts & 28 rows = 4x4"

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 18 sts. Work 2 rows in 1x1 ribbing, **except** for the first and last 2 sts which are **always** worked in garter st, *increasing* 1 st at each edge (= 2 sts in from the edges) of all the rows (= on all right side rows and on all wrong side rows).

Continue working in *pattern* st 1, following graph A. **Note:** The 2 sts in *garter* st at the sides and the **increases** are not represented on the graphs. When the 22 rows of graph A have been completed, continue working in *pattern* st 2 following graph B. When all the rows of graph B have been completed, continue working in *pattern* st 1 & 2 in the following


* Work the last 10 rows of graph A (= R1), the 12 rows of graph B *, work from * to * a total of 4 times and finish with the last 10 rows of graph A (= R1).

Continue working in *pattern* st 3, following graph C.

Note: make the centre of graph C match the centre of the work.


When all the rows of graph C have been completed continue working in *garter st* until the end of the ball of yarn and **bind (cast off)** all the sts.


- Repeat
- 1 knit st
- 1 purl st
- > Using the RH needle pick up 5 purl sts, purl the 5 sts tog, without releasing the 5 sts from the LH needle add 1 YO and purl the 5 sts tog again, without releasing the 5 sts from the LH needle add 1 YO and purl the 5 sts tog again. Total = 5 sts on the RH needle and release the 5 sts on the LH needle. /
