## One Skein Sonata Scarf

*By Kat Coyle*



**Yarn** *Noro Sonata* (35% Cotton, 25% Viscose, 20% Silk, 20% Polyamide); 393 yd / 100 g; 1 skein

**Needles** US 7/4.5 mm 32" circ

**Notions** stitch markers, tapestry needle for weaving in ends

**Gauge** 16 sts and 30 rows = 4" in Garter Stitch before blocking.

14 sts and 28 rows = 4" in Garter Stitch after blocking.

**Finished Size** Before Blocking Width (wingspan) about 44", Depth 22" at center spine.

After Blocking Width (Wingspan) about 53", Depth 26" at center spine.

**Note** This triangle shawl is knit from the top down. Four stitches are increased every right side row.

### Stitch Guide

**Garter Stitch** Row 1 (RS): Knit. Row 2 (WS): Knit.

**Crest of the Wave Lace** (multiple of 12 sts)

Row 1(RS): \*(K2tog) 2 times, (yo, k1) 3 times, yo, (ssk) 2 times, k1; rep from \*.

Rows 2, 4, 6, 8 (WS): Purl.

Rows 3, 5, 7: Repeat Row 1.

Rows 9-12: Knit.

### Pattern

**Garter Stitch Section** Cast on 3 sts.

Row 1 (RS): Knit 1, yo, k1, yo, k1. (5 sts)

Row 2 (and all even numbered [WS] rows): Knit.

Row3: (Knit 1, yo) four times, k1. (9 sts)

Row 5: Knit 1, yo, k3, yo, place marker, k1(center st), place marker, yo, k3, yo, k1. (13 sts)

Row 7 - 97: Increase 4 sts every RS odd numbered row as follows: k1, yo, k to marker, yo, slip marker, k center st, slip marker, yo, k to last st, yo, k1.

Row 98: Knit. (197 sts)



### **Begin Lace Section.**

Row 1: Knit 1, \* yo, k1, place marker, work Row 1 of Crest of the Wave Lace (8 times), place marker \*, yo, slip marker, k center st, slip marker, rep from \* to \*, yo, k1.

Row 2 (slide markers as you come to them): K2, purl to center stitch, knit center stitch, purl to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 3: Knit 1, yo, k to marker, \* slip marker, work Row 3 of Crest of the Wave Lace (8 times) to next marker \*, k to center st, yo, slip marker, k1 (center st), slip marker, yo, k to marker, rep from \* to \*, slip marker, k to last st, yo, k1.

Row 4, 6 and 8: Repeat Row 2.

Row 5 and 7: Repeat Row 3.

Rows 9-12: Knit. Remember to inc every odd numbered row.

Rows 13-16: Repeat last 4 rows. (229 sts)

### **Picot Point Bind Off**

- \*With Knit Cast On method CO 2 sts, BO 7, pass st on RH needle to LH needle; repeat from \* 4 times.
  - \*With Knit Cast On method CO 2 sts, BO 8, pass st on RH needle to LH needle; repeat from \* 15 times.
  - \*With Knit Cast On method CO 2 sts, BO 5, pass st on RH needle to LH needle; repeat from \* 2 times.
  - \*With Knit Cast On method CO 2 sts, BO 8, pass st on RH needle to LH needle; repeat from \* 17 times.
  - \*With Knit Cast On method CO 2 sts, BO 7, pass st on RH needle to LH needle; repeat from \* 2 times.
- With Knit Cast On method CO 2, BO 2. Cut yarn, pull through rem st.

### **Finishing**

Weave in loose ends. Soak in cool water and lay flat to dry.

### **Abbreviations**

BO: bind off

CO: cast on

k: knit

k2tog: knit two stitches together

Knit Cast On: knit next st on LH needle, do not remove old stitch, place new st on LH needle.

LH: left hand

p: purl

rep: repeat

RH: right hand

RS: right side

ssk: slip slip knit; slip stitch knitwise (twice), knit together through the back loops.

st(s): stitch(es)

yo: yarn over right hand needle
