



BIG PAINT SCARF



MEASUREMENTS: 9 1/2" (24 cm) wide x 74 3/4" (190 cm) long, approximately, **without** the fringe.

MATERIALS

BIG PAINT: 3 balls col. 201

Knitting needles: size 11 (U.S.)/(8 mm)

Stitches

Garter st, stockinette st, reverse stockinette st, fringe, Relief st (see graph A)

GAUGE

Using the size 11 needles in *relief st*:
12 sts & 16 rows = 4x4"

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 29 sts. Work 4 rows in *garter st* then continue working in *relief st* following graph A, **except** for the first and last 2 sts which are worked in *garter st*.

Note: This yarn has stripes of colours that are the same length, when starting a new ball of yarn take care to start it with the first full colour stripe section.

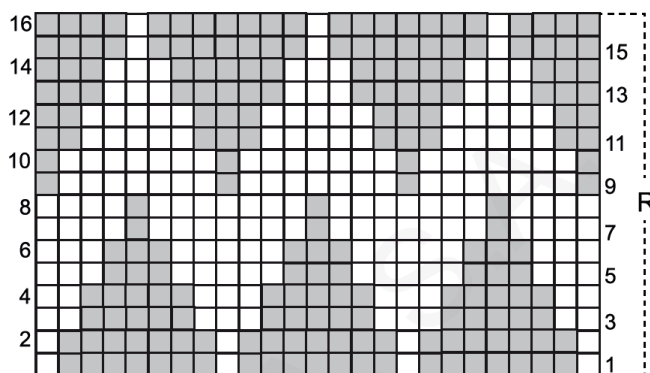
Before starting the 3rd ball of yarn, **cut** the strands for the fringes (as indicated in the section Finishing & Making Up) then use the rest of the ball to finish the scarf.

When the scarf measures 74" (188 cm), measuring from the start, work 4 rows in *garter st* then **bind (cast off)** all the sts.

FINISHING (MAKING UP)

Fringe: **cut** 60 strips each measuring 16 7/8" (43 cm) long.

Attach 15 fringes (each fringe = 2 strands of yarn) to each end of the scarf.
