KASHWOOL



EN/ KASHWOOL SHAWL

MEASUREMENTS: 17 3/4" wide x 59" long (45

cm x 150 cm), without fringing.

MATERIALS

KASHWOOL: 2 balls col. 306

Crochet hook: size E4 (U.S.)/(3.5 mm)

Stitches

Double crochet, single crochet, chain st,

fringe.

Pattern st (see graph A)

GAUGE

Using the size E4 hook in *pattern st* 2.5 motifs & 7 rows = 4x4"

INSTRUCTIONS

Chain 69 sts and continue working in *pattern st* following graph A.

When shawl measures 59" (150 cm) measuring from the start and after finishing the last 2 rows of graph A, **cut** the yarn and **fasten off**.

FINISHING (MAKING UP)

Fringe: cut 132 strands of yarn each measuring 17 3/4" (45 cm) long. Attach 11 fringes (each fringe = 6 strands of yarn) to each end of the shawl.
