Ocean Breeze Shawl

Description: The color changes in the yarn and simple eyelets create the look of waves created by an ocean breeze. You'll want to keep this on your shoulders all year long.

Sizes: One Size (after blocking)

Length: ~72"Width: ~17"

Materials:

- Yarn: Luci (Louisa Harding)
 - o 2 cakes, 2 different colorways
 - 700 yards
- Needles: US7 (4.5mm)
- Tapestry needle
- Stitch markers, optional

Gauge

 Varies. A loose gauge will result in a greater drape. If you want a lacier effect, choose larger needles. Recognize that this will alter the listed dimensions and required yardage.

Stitch Patterns and Abbreviations

- **K** = Knit
- **P** = Purl
- YO = Yarn over

- DD = Double decrease (Slip 2 stitches knitwise, K1. Pass 2 stitches over the knitted stitch)
- **P2TogTBL** = Purl 2 stitches together, through the back loop
- **P2Tog** = Purl 2 stitches together



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This pattern is a repeat of 12 + 9

With Color A: Cast on 81 stitches

Set Up Rows (do not repeat): Knit 2 rows

Row 1 (and all RS rows): *(K4, YO, K1, YO, K4, DD)* 6 times, K4, YO, K1, YO, K4 (83

stitches)

Row 2 (and all WS rows): P2TogTBL, Purl to last 2 stitches, P2Tog (81 stitches)

Change to Color B and repeat Rows 1 and 2

Repeat these two rows alternating colors A and B every two rows until you have just enough for 2 knit rows and then a bind off row.

Wet block for optimal results



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
