

THE COLOR EVOLUTION



CARDIGAN

MATERIALS

FIRENZE by Laines Du Nord colour 404 - 270 grams A pair of US15/10mm needles 4 medium sizes buttons

ONE SIZE

Finished Measurements Width 47cm/120cm Length 27"/70cm Sleeve Length 12"/30cm

LACE STITCH

Row 1: K1, * yf, K2tog, * rep * to * to the last st, K1. Row 2: Purl Row 3: K1, * K2tog, yf,* rep * to * to the last st, K1. Row 4: Purl Rep these 4 rows as required.

NOTE

No actual buttonhole is made when knitting the bands as the bands are worked on the same big needle as the body. This means that the bands are loose sts so the buttonhole is made by pushing the button through a few times.

ABBREVIATIONS

sts = stitch(es) RS = right side WS =wrong side K = knit P = purl tog = together yf = yarn forward rep = repeat cont = continue patt = pattern inc = increasing foll = following

BACK

With US15/10mm needles cast on 54sts and wk K1, P1, rib for 2 rows.

Cont in lace patt until back measures 27"/70cm from beginning ending with a WS row.

Cast off.

RIGHT FRONT

With US15/10mm needles cast on 29sts and wk K1, P1 rib for 2 rows.

Cont in Lace patt as follows: **

Row 1: (RS) Rib as set 5sts, wk lace patt to end.

Row 2: Wk lace patt to the last 5sts, rib as set 5sts.

Repeating the 4 rows of lace patt rep the last 2 rows until front measures $12^{\circ}/30$ cm from beg ending with a WS row.

Shape Neck Row 1: (RS) Rib 5sts, wk2tog, patt to end. Patt 7 rows. Rep the last 8 rows 3 times more. 25sts rem. Patt straight until front measures same as back ending with a RS row. NR: (WS) Cast off 20sts, rib 5sts. Cont on these 5sts for a further 3"/8cm. Cast off. **LEFT FRONT** Wk as given for right front up to ** Wk lace patt as follows: Row 1: (RS) Wk lace patt for 24sts, rib as set 5sts. Row 2: Rib as set 5sts, wk lace patt to end. Cont as for right front working the neck shaping in reverse as follows: Shape Neck Row 1: (RS) Patt to the last 7sts, wk2tog, rib 5sts. Patt 7 rows. Rep the last 8 rows 3 times more. 25sts rem. Patt straight until front measures same as back ending with a WS row. NR: (RS) Cast off 20sts. rib 5sts. Cont on these 5sts for a further 3"/8cm. Cast off. **SLEEVES** With US15/10mm needles cast on 24sts and work K1, P1 rib for 2 rows. Work lace patt AT THE SAME TIME inc 1 st at each end of the 3rd row and every foll 10th row until 32sts on the needle. (total of 4 inc at each side) Patt straight until sleeve measures 12"/30cm or required length ending with a WS row Cast off. POCKET With US15/10mm needles cast on 14sts and work in Lace patt for 15 rows. Work 2 rows K1, P1, rib. Cast off. MAKEUP

Join shoulder seams. Join bands at center back neck and sew to back neck edge.

Sew in sleeves thus: pin center point of sleeve cast off edge to shoulder seam and stitch to body working from shoulder down to underarm. Sew up side and sleeve seams matching lace patt. Sew on buttons evenly spaced as seen in Photo.
