

THE COLOR EVOLUTION



CROCUS BEANIE

MATERIALS

Matera by Laines Du Nord 80 grm colour no 1 (pink) 50 grm colour 13 (cream)

A pair of US7/4.5mm needles tapestry needles, pins, scissors

SIZE

One size

STITCHES USED

Tubular cast on

K1, P1 rib:

Row 1: slip 1, * K1, P1 *, rep from * to * to last stitch, slip 1 **Row 2:** slip 1, K all K sts and P all P sts to the last st, slip 1. Rep these 2 Rows

Fabric garter st: (on an even number of stitches)

Row 1: (RS): with color pink, K1, * K1, slip 1 st knitwise *, rep from * to * to the last st, P1. **Row 2:(WS):** with color pink, slip 1 * slip 1 st purlwise, K1 *, rep from * to * to the last st, K1.

Row 3: with color cream, K1, * slip 1 st knitwise, K1 *, rep from * to * to the last st, P1.

Row 4: with color cream, K1, * K1, slip 1 st purlwise *, rep from * to * to last st, P1.

DIFFICULTY LEVEL

Intermediate

ABBREVIATIONS

RS = right side WS = wrong side st(s) = Stitch(es) K = knit P = purl rep = repeat cont = continue

INSTRUCTIONS

With US7/4.5mm needles and color pink, cast on 60sts and work 4 rows in tubular st.

Then work in K1, P1 rib for the 3"/8cm.

Cont in fabric garter st until work measures 7"/17cm from the beginning.

Now divide sts into 5 parts of 12 sts each and work them separately.

On RS rows decrease 1 st on both sides of each part every 2 rows until all sts are decreased.

MAKEUP

Sew the adjacent edges of the 5 parts together, then sew the side edges of the beanie together. Sew in all threads.
