## PULL CANDY

## MATERIALS

Poema by Laines du Nord
Color 300-2 balls
US4/3.5mm and US6/4mm circular needles, 100 cm long for body and 60 cm long for sleeves.

## SIZES

$S(M, L)$. Size $M$ in photo.

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width (underarm) $361 / 2(40,44]$ "/92(101,112)cm
Length $21(21,22)$ " $/ 53(53,56) \mathrm{cm}$
Sleeve Length 8(8,81/2)"/20(20,21)cm

## GAUGE

24 sts $\times 30$ rows $=4 " / 10 \mathrm{~cm}$ square over stocking st using US6/4mm needles.

## ABBREVIATIONS

St(s) = stitch(es); $\mathrm{K}=$ knit; $\mathbf{P}=$ purl; SM = slip marker; tog = together; yo = yarn over; rep= repeat; patt = pattern; inc = increase; dec = decrease; wk = work.
M1K = make one stitch thus: pick up horizontal loop lying between last stitch worked and next stitch and knit into back of loop.
Skpo = slip 1, K1, pass slipped stitch over

## NOTE

This sweater is worked in rounds from the top down, with circular yoke.

## Patt X (12sts x 8 rows)

Round 1: K6, yo, K2tog, K4
Round 2: K12sts
Round 3: K4, yo, K2tog, K2, yo, k2tog, K2
Round 4: K12sts.
Round 5: K2, yf, K2tog, K6, yo, K2tog.
Round 6: Knit 12sts.
Round 7: yo, K2tog, K10
Round 8: K12sts.

## YOKE

With US $4 / 3.5 \mathrm{~mm}$ needles cast on $104(108,114)$ sts plus 1 st and working in rounds work as follows:
(ensuring that the work is not twisted when joining the round by K2tog (the last cast on stitch and the first stitch = $104(108,114)$ sts)
Rounds 1-10: * K1, P1 * rep from * to * to end.
Change to US6/4mm needles
Rounds 11-13: Knit to end.
Round 14: Knit to end inc $28(36,42)$ sts evenly across row. [132 $(144,156)$ sts]
Rounds 15-16: Knit to end.
Rounds 17: *wk round 1 of patt X for 12 sts* rep * to * to end. Cont until the 8 rounds off patt X worked.

Rounds 25-27: Knit to end.
Round 28: Knit to end inc $48(48,52)$ sts evenly. [180 $(192$, 208) sts]

Rounds 29-31: Knit to end.
Round 32: Purl to end.
Round 33: * K2tog, yo * rep from * to * to end.
Round 34: Purl to end.
Rounds 35-38: Knit to end.
Round 39: Knit to end inc $48(48,44)$ sts evenly across row. [228 (240, 252) sts]
Rounds 40-42: Knit to end.
Row 43: *wk round 1 of patt X for 12 sts* rep * to * to end.
Cont until the 8 rounds off patt X worked.
Rounds 51-53: Knit to end.
Round 54: * K3, M1K * rep * to * to end. [304 $(320,336)$ sts]
Rounds 55-68: Knit to end.
Rounds 69: Knit to end inc $64(80,104)$ sts evenly across row. [368 $(400,440)$ sts]
Rounds 70-77: Knit to end.
Size L only: Knit 5 rounds
Divide for Front, Back \& Sleeves
Place the first $74(80,88)$ sts onto a st holder (first sleeve), knit the next $110(120,132)$ sts (front), place the next 74 $(80,88)$ sts onto 2 nd st holder (second sleeve), K110 (120, 132) sts (back).

Body sts (back and front): $220(240,264)$ sts.
BODY
Round 1: K110 (120, 132) sts, place a colored marker (indicates side seam) K110 $(120,132)$ sts.
Dec round 1: K2tog, knit to 3sts before colored marker, skpo, K1, SM, K2tog, knit to 3sts before end, skpo, K1.
Knit 12 rounds
Dec round 2: K2tog, knit to 3sts before colored marker, skpo, K1, SM, K2tog, knit to 3sts before end, skpo, K1.
Knit 12 rounds.
Dec round 3: K2tog, knit to 3sts before colored marker, skpo, K1,SM, K2tog, knit to 3sts before end, skpo, K1.
K40 $(42,46)$ rounds.
Hem
Round 1: Purl to end.
Round 2: * K2tog, yo * rep from * to * to end.
Round 3: Purl to end.
Rounds 4, 5 and 6: Knit to end.
Rep from Round 1 to Round 6 one more time.
Change to US $4 / 3.5 \mathrm{~mm}$ needles and wk as follows:
Next round: * K1, P1, rep from * to end.
Rep the last round 9 times more. Cast off.

## SLEEVES

Slip the $74(80,88)$ sts from st holder onto US6/4mm needles.
Place a colored marker in the center of the underarm sts.
Working in rounds work as follows:
Round 1: Purl to end.
Round 2: * K2tog, yo * rep from * to * to end
Round 3: Purl to end.
Knit $54(54,56)$ rounds.
Work 6 rounds in K1, P1 rib.
Cast loosely. Rep for the 2nd sleeve.
