



# THE COLOR EVOLUTION



## OPTICAL JERSEY

Cashsilk Light & Dollyna by Laines Du nord

### MATERIALS

4 balls of CASHSILK LIGHT colour 3041  
4 balls of CASHSILK LIGHT colour 3042  
4 balls of DOLLYNA colour 406  
4 balls of DOLLYNA colour 1

A pair of US7/4.5mm and US8/5mm circular needles.  
DPNs = double pointed needles.  
stitch markers, tapestry needle.

### SIZES

S (M, L)  
Size in photos M

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width (underarm) 37½(40,45)"/ 94(101,114)cm  
Full length 20(21,23)"/51(53,58)cm  
Length from underarm to hem: 11½(12,12½)"/29(30,31)cm  
Sleeve length: 16(16,16)"/41(41,41)cm

### TENSION

18 stitches and 25 rows = 10 X10 cm (4x4") in stocking st.  
using US8/5mm needles.

### NOTES

This garment is worked in rounds from the top down with raglan sleeves.  
Yarn is doubled using 1 strand of Dollyna and 1 strand of Cash silk Light together.

### ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit;  
P = purl;  
st(s) = stitch(es);  
SM = stitch marker;  
K2tog = knit 2 sts together;  
Kfb = knit into front and back of the next stitch (increases 1 stitch)  
Rep = repeat  
cont = continue  
Colour 1 = Dollyna color 1 and Cashsilk color 3041 worked together  
Colour 2 = Dollyna color 406 and Cashsilk color 3042 worked together

### BODY

Beg at neck edge and working in rounds:  
With US7/4.5mm circular needle and colour 1 cast on 90(98,98)sts, place SM and join in the round.  
**Rounds 1 - 6:** work in K1, P1 rib.  
**Round 7:** Knit to end

Change to US8/5mm needles and cont in colour sequence as follows:

5 rounds with color 1

5 rounds with color 2

Working this colour sequence throughout cont as follows:

**Round 8:** Knit to end

**Round 9:** place stitch markers to indicate increases as follows: Place a SM of the beginning of the round, K8(10,10), (first sleeve), place a SM, K2, place a SM, K33(35,35) (front), place a SM, K2, place a SM, K8(10,10) (second sleeve), place a SM, K2, place a SM, K33(35,35) (back), place a SM, K2.

Now start increases to form sleeves, back and front as follows:

**Round 10:** kfb, K to 1 st before SM, kfb, K2, kfb, K to 1 st before SM, kfb, K2, kfb, K to 1 st before SM, kfb, K2, kfb, K to 1 st before SM, kfb, K2 (8 sts increased)

**Round 11:** Knit to end.

Rep Rounds 10 and 11, 22 (24, 29) times more.

Now place the sts for each sleeve onto a st holder as follows: Place the first 54(60,70)sts onto a st holder (first sleeve), cast on 2(2,4) sts for underarm, K83(89,99)sts, place the next 54(60,70)sts onto another st holder (second sleeve), cast on 2(2,4) sts for underarm, K83(89,99)sts.

Work body of sweater.

Working across the 83(89,99) front sts and the 83(89,99) back sts (170(182,206)sts)

Work in stocking st (Knit all rounds), and cont with color sequence as set (5 rounds with color 1 and 5 rounds with color 2) cont until the sweater measures 10(10½,11)"/25(27,28)) cm from underarm.

Change to US7/4.5mm needles and wk hem as follows:

Work 6 rounds of K1, P1, rib using colour 1.

Cast off all stitches.

### SLEEVES (All Sizes)

Cont with colour sequence working as follows:

Slip the 54(60,70)sts from st holder onto US8/5mm needle and using DPNs pick up and knit 2(2,4) underarm sts. 56(62,74)sts.

Place SM in the center of the underarm sts.

Working in rounds and working in stocking st (K all rounds), and cont with colour sequence (5 rounds with color 1 and 5 rounds with color 2) until the sleeve measures 14½(37cm) from underarm.

**Next round:** Knit to end dec 16sts evenly.

Change to US7/4.5mm needles and wk cuff as follows:

Work 10 rounds in K1,P1 rib.

Cast off all stitches.

Work 2nd sleeve to match first sleeve.
