

## GRANNY SQUARE COAT

## MATERIALS

Vasto by Laines Du Nord
$12 \times 50 \mathrm{gram}$ balls of color 12 (grey)
$1 \times 50 \mathrm{grm}$ ball of 01 (cream)
$1 \times 50 \mathrm{grm}$ ball of 05 (Tan)
$1 \times 50 \mathrm{grm}$ ball of 06 (Pumpkin)
$1 \times 50 \mathrm{grm}$ ball of 08 (red)
$1 \times 50 \mathrm{grm}$ ball of 11 (bottle)
$1 \times 50 \mathrm{grm}$ ball of 09 (black)
US8/5mm crochet hook
Us8/5mm knitting needle

## GAUGE

One Granny motif $=5 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime} /(14 \times 14 \mathrm{~cm})$
LEVEL: Intermediate

## NOTE

The coat consists of 64 granny motifs joined together,

## ABBREVIATIONS

RS = right side of work
WS = wrong side of work
sts $=$ stitch/stitches
ch = chain stitch
hdc = half double crochet
dc = double crochet
rep $=$ repeat/repeating
p = purl
beg = begin/beginning
cont = continue
sc = single crochet
sl st = slip stitch.
sp = space

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Granny motif

With US8/5mm crochet hook and one color of your choice (not grey as this is the main color) make 4ch, join with a sl st to form a ring.
Working the first 4 rounds in colors of your choice work as follows:
Round 1: 5ch (count as 1dc and 2ch), [3dc into ring, 2ch] 3 times, 2 dc into ring, sl st to 3 rd of 5 ch .
Round 2: Sl st into next ch, 5ch, (count as 1dc and 2ch), 3dc into same sp, * 1ch, miss 3dc, [3dc, 2ch, 3dc] into next sp, rep from * twice, 1ch, miss 3sts, 2dc into same sp as 5ch at beg of round, sl st to 3 rd of 5 ch .
Round 3: sl st into next ch, 5ch, (count as 1dc and 2ch), 3dc into same sp, *1ch, miss 3dc, 3dc into next sp, 1ch, miss 3dc, ** [3dc, 2ch, 3dc] into next sp, rep from * twice and from * to ${ }^{* *}$ again, 2 dc into same sp as 5 ch , sl st to 3 rd of 5 ch .

Round 4: sl st into next ch, 5ch, (count as 1dc and 2ch), 3dc into same sp, *[1ch, miss 3dc, 3dc into next sp] twice, 1ch, miss 3dc, ${ }^{* *}$ [3dc, 2ch, 3dc] into next sp, rep from * twice and from * to ** again, 2dc into same sp as 5ch, sl st to 3rd of 5ch.
Round 5: (in color grey) sl st into next ch, 5ch, (count as 1dc and 2ch), 3dc into same sp, *[1ch, miss 3dc, 3dc into next sp] 3 times, 1ch, miss 3dc, ** [3dc, 2ch, 3dc] into next sp, rep from * twice and from * to ** again, 2dc into same sp as 5ch, sl st to 3rd of 5ch.
Round 6: (in color grey) 1ch, work 1sc into every st to end working 1 ch into each corner 2ch, sl st to first st.
Round 7: (in color grey).5ch, work 1sc into each st to end working 5ch into each corner ch, sl st to first ch.
Fasten off.

## Joining of the motifs

Work 64 granny motifs in total, changing the color of first 4 rounds as you like or follow the colors in photo.
After working the 2nd motif, join it to first one or the previous ones, across the 7th round.
At each joining point, work as follows.: after working 1 ch or 1sc in current motif, remove the crochet hook and insert it into corresponding ch or sc of adjacent motif (from back to front), pick up the sts you have left, yarn over and pull it through both loops on your crochet hook, 1ch, cont working the 7 th round of current motif as before.
Cont joining of the motifs until you have made one piece, that includes the right front, the left front, the sleeves and the back (as per the diagram).
Fold the piece in half, following the red lines shown in the diagram.
Sew undersleeves and sides.
Fold the 2 motifs at the armpits and following the diagram join the sides $A$ with $A, B$ with $B, C$ with $C$ and $D$ with $D$.

## EDGING

Using color grey and US8/5mm crochet hook work 1dc, 1 hdc, 2dc into each st around hem and around sleeve ends.
Using US8/5mm knitting needles and using the colors moss and cream together cast on 5sts and work as follows:
Row 1: K1, [P1, K1] twice.
Row 2: $K$ the $K$ sts and $P$ the $P$ sts.
Cut the yarns leaving at least 2 " $/ 5 \mathrm{~cm}$ to spare.
Row 3: Using Red and pumpkin together rib as set to end.
Row 4: As row 3.
Cut yarns as before.
Always leave the cast-on and cast off yarns on the same side. Cont in rib, alternating the colors every 2 rows and breaking off and joining in yarn as set.
Cont until band measures up right front, across back neck and done left front.
Sew band in place.
Trim fringes evenly by $2 " / 5 \mathrm{~cm}$ (approx) from band edge.
