



# THE COLOR EVOLUTION



## SILK SCARF WITH TASSEL

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy

### MATERIALS

Cash Silk Light by Laines Du Nord

2 balls x 25 grams in any color of your preference (col. 3052 shown)

A pair of US 10/6mm needles.

darning needle, tape measure, cardboard strip 5½"/14cm in length.

**STITCHES:** Stocking stitch (RS knit, WS purl)

### ABBREVIATIONS

st./sts. = stitch/stitches

Stockinette stitch (RS knit, WS purl)

### FINISHED MEASUREMENT

Approx. 63 x 13"/160 x 34 cm

### SCARF

With US10/6mm needles cast on 40sts and work 63"/160 cm in stockinette st.

Cast off.

### FINISHING

**Tassel (make 2):** wrap yarn around the cardboard strip 40 times. At the top, pass same yarn between the cardboard and the wrapped yarn, knot it, leaving 2 loose ends for sewing tassel to scarf.

At opposite edge, cut the yarns and remove the cardboard.

For "head" shaping, at approx. 1/3cm from knot, wrap yarn around the tassel several times Trim tassel.

Using the darning needle, pass the same yarn through the edge stitches of first short side of scarf, pull the yarn gently to curl and tighten the edge, sew a couple of sts to secure. Repeat on the opposite side.

Sew 2 tassels at the center of 2 curled edges of the scarf.
