



THE COLOR EVOLUTION



STRIPED SWEATER

MATERIALS

SOFT LINO by Laines Du Nord
150 grm colour 2 (cream)
100 grm colour 11 (dark green)
100 grm colour 22 (yellow)
50 grm colour 20 (wisteria)

A pair each of US3/3.25mm and US4/3.5mm.

SIZE: 40"/101cm

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width 31½"/80cm
Length 19½"/50cm
Sleeve length 18"/46cm

STITCHES USED

Tubular st

Stocking st: (RS rows K, WS rows P)

K1, P1 rib

Row 1: * K1, P1 * rep from * to *.

Row 2: K all K sts and P all P sts.

DIFFICULTY LEVEL

Easy

ABBREVIATIONS

st(s) = Stitch(es)
RS = right side
WS = wrong side
K = knit
P = purl
inc = increase
dec = decrease
col. = color
cont = continue
rep = repeat (ing)

FRONT

With US3/3.25mm needles and colour 22 (yellow), cast on 100sts.

Work 2 rows in tubular st.

Work 12 rows in K1, P1 rib.

Change to US4/3.5 mm needles and working in stocking st, cont in color sequence as follows:

2 rows in colour. 22 (yellow)
6 rows in colour 11 (dark green)
2 rows in colour 22 (yellow)
2 rows in colour 2 (cream)
2 rows in colour 20 (wisteria)
1 row in colour 11 (dark green)
6 rows in colour 2 (cream)
2 rows in colour 20 (wisteria)

6 rows in colour 2 (cream)
1 row in colour 11 (dark green)
2 rows in colour 20 (wisteria)
2 rows in colour 2 (cream)

Rep this color sequence throughout, cont until front measures 17"/43cm from beg ending with a WS row.

Shape Shoulder

Cast off 5sts at the beg of the next 4 rows. [80sts rem]

Work another 2 rows in stocking st.

Change to US3/3.25mm needles and work 7 rows in 1/1 rib.
Wk 2 rows in tubular st.

Cast off

BACK

Work as for the Front.

SLEEVES

With US3/3.25mm needles and colour 22 (yellow) cast on 44 sts.

Work 2 rows in tubular st.

Work 12 rows K1, P1, rib.

Change to US4/3.5 mm needles and work in stocking st and color stripe sequence as given for front AT THE SAME TIME inc 1 st each end of every 6th row until sleeve measures 18"/46cm from beg and ending with a WS row.

Cast off.

FINISHING

Join shoulder seams. Sew in sleeves thus: pin center point of sleeve cast off edge to shoulder seams and stitch to body working from shoulder down to underarm. Sew up side and sleeve seams matching stripes. Sew in all loose threads.
