



THE COLOR EVOLUTION



SWEATER

MATERIALS

Baby Soft by Laines du Nord
2 balls in each colours: 502 (sand), 604 (yellow), 602 (light green), and 603 (dark green.)
A pair each of US3/3.25mm, US4/3.5 and US6/4mm needles.

SIZE

40"/101cm.

GAUGE

21sts x 22 rows = 4x4" (10x10cm) in stocking stitch using size US6/4mm knitting needles.

SKILL LEVEL

Intermediate.

ABBREVIATIONS

sts = stitch(es)
RS = right side
WS = wrong side
k = knit
p = purl
rep = repeat
Cont = continue

FRONT

With US4/3.5mm needles cast on 104sts using colour 502 sand and knit 1 row.

Work 4 rows tubular st.

Then work rib as follows:

Row 1: * K1, P1, rep from * to end.

Row 2: K all K sts and P all P sts to end

Rep the last 2 rows 3 times more.

Change to US6/4mm needles and work in stocking st as follows:

Row 1: (RS) K24 sand, K36 light green, K28 yellow, K16 dark green.

Row 2: Purl to end in colours set on previous row.

Rep the last 2 rows 6 times more.

Row 15: Patt as set to the last 2sts, K2 sand.

Row 16: Purl to end in colours set.

Row 17: As row 15.

Row 18: P3 sand purl to end in colours set.

Cont in colours set working an extra st into sand (as set) on every row for a further 4 rows.

Row 23: Knit to end in colours set.

Cont in colours set working an extra 2sts into sand on every row for a further 3 rows.

Row 27: Knit to end in colours set.

Row 28: K24 sand, K36 light green, K28 yellow, K16 sand.

Patt 11 rows in colours set.

Row 40: K24 sand, K36 light green, K44 sand.

Patt 12 rows in colours set.

Row 53: K24 light green, knit to end in sand.

Patt 16 rows in colours set.

Row 70: P16 dark green, patt in colours set to end

Patt 2 rows in colours set.

Row 73: K88 sand, K16 dark green.

Row 74: Patt to end in colours set.

Row 75: K60 sand, K28 yellow and K16 sts dark green.

Patt 5 rows in colours set.

Row 81: K24 sand, 36 light green, 28 yellow, 16 dark green.

Patt 15 rows in colours set.

Shape front Neck

Keeping to colours set.

Row 97: (RS) Patt 43sts turn and put rem sts on a spare needle.

Row 98: Cast off 6sts and patt to end.

Row 99: Patt to end.

Row 100: Cast off 4sts and patt to end.

Row 101: Patt to end.

Row 102: Cast off 3sts and patt to end.

Row 103: Patt to end.

Cast off rem 30sts for shoulder.

With RS facing rejoin yarn to sts on the spare needle and cast off the centre 18sts.

Cont on rem 43sts and complete to match first side reversing shaping.

BACK

Work as given for front omitting neck shaping.

SLEEVE

With US4/3.5mm needles cast on 64sts using shade 502 (sand) and knit 1 row.

Wk 4 rows tubular st.

Then work 8 rows K1, P1 rib as given for back.

Change to US6/4mm needles and cont in stocking st as follows:

Row 1: (RS) K20 light green, K28 yellow, K10 sand, K6 dark green

Row 2: Purl to end in colours set.

Row 3: Knit to end in colours set inc 1 st at each end of row.

Row 4: As row 2.

Row 5: Knit to end in colours set.

Row 6: As row 2.

Row 7: As row 3.

Patt 5 rows in colours set.

Row 13: As row 3.

Patt 5 rows in colours set.

Row 19: As row 3.

Row 20: Patt as set to end.

Row 21: Patt to end working sand instead of light green.

Patt as set 3 rows.

Row 25: As row 3.

Patt as set 3 rows.

Row 29: Knit to end in sand.

Row 30: Purl to end in sand.

Row 31: Knit to end in sand inc 1 st at each end of row.

Wk 7 rows in sand.

Row 39: K26 dark green, knit to end in sand.

Row 40: Purl to end in colours set.

Row 41: Patt to end inc 1 st at each end of row.

Patt as set 3 rows.

Row 45: K27 dark green, 14 light green, knit to end in sand.

Patt as set 3 rows.

Row 49: As 41.

Patt 3 rows.

Row 53: K28 dark green, 14 light green, 18 yellow, knit to end in sand.

Patt as set 3 rows.

Row 57: K28 sand, patt as set to end.

Patt 9 rows.

Wk 16 rows in sand.

Cast off.

COLLAR

Join right shoulder seam.

With US4/3.5mm needles and sand pick up and K96sts evenly around neckline.

Purl one row.

Work 3 rows K1, P1, rib.

Work 3 rows tubular st.

Cast off.

MAKEUP

Join left shoulder and neckband seams. Sew in sleeves thus: pin center point of sleeve cast off edge to shoulder seam and stitch to body working from shoulder down to underarm. Sew upside and sleeve seams. Sew in all loose threads.
