



# THE COLOR EVOLUTION



## COWL

**SKILL LEVEL:** Intermediate

### MATERIALS

2 balls x 50 grams of Alpaca Color by Laines du Nord  
size US15/10 mm knitting needles  
Darning needle with silicon eye  
Pins  
Scissors  
Tape measure

### STITCHES USED

**Rib in slipped stitches:** 2 stitches.

**1st r.:** k1, slip 1 st. p-wise.

**2nd r.:** slip 1 st. p-wise, k1.

Rep. 1st and 2nd r. reaching the stated length.

**Honeycomb stitch:** even stitches.

**1st r.:** knit.

**2nd r.:** (k1, 1 double st.) rep. across the entire r.

**3rd r.:** knit.

**4th r.:** (1 double st., k1) rep. across the entire r.

Rep. from 1st to 4th r. reaching the stated length.

**Double stitch:** insert the right knitting needle under next st. (not into next st.) on left knitting needle and knit it.

**Binding off:** slip 1st st. k-wise, knit next st., pass slipped st. over knitted st., (knit next st., pass 1st st. over 2nd st. of right knitting needle) rep. like stated.

### ABBREVIATIONS

RS = right side of work

WS = wrong side of work

st. / es = stitch / es

r. = row / s

k = knit

rep. = repeat / ing

fol. = follow / ing

### INSTRUCTIONS

Using size US15/10 mm knitting needles, cast-on 36 sts. and work as foll.: 2 sts. for rib in slipped sts., 32 sts for honeycomb stitch, 2 sts. for rib in slipped sts.

Work according to the pattern reaching 140 cm in length, then bind off all sts. Cut yarn leaving long tail.

Thread the darning needle, fold scarf in half (RS against RS) and join edges of first and last row, inserting the darning needle through every couple of corresponding stitches of both layers. Hide the ends on WS. Turn the collar RS out.
