## OPEN CARDIGAN

## MATERIALS

Poema Stripes by Laines du Nord: $3 \times 150 \mathrm{~g}$ balls in color 05 Interchangeable circular needles size US6/4mm points, 32 "/ 80 cm cable.
Short points circular needles size US6/4mm points, 16 " 40 cm cable.
Cable needle
Stitch marker
Darning needle
Scissors
Tape measure

## GAUGE

22 stitches and 33 rows $=4 " / 10 \mathrm{~cm}$ square in stocking st. using size US6/4mm knitting needles, measured after blocking.

## ABBREVIATIONS

RS = right side of work
WS = wrong side of work
SM = stitch marker*
$\mathrm{SMb}=$ stitch marker of the beginning of the round
st. / sts. = stitch / stitches
col. = color
k = knit
r. = row / rows
k2tog $=$ knit 2 stitches together
p2tog = purl 2 stitches together
rep. = repeat / repeating
p = purl
cont. = continue / continuing
foll. = follow / following
sl1 p-wise = slip 1 stitch purl-wise.
sl1 k-wise = slip 1 stitch knit-wise.
Cross 3 L = cross 3 stitches to the left (slip 2 stitches onto a cable needle, let cable needle hang in front of work, p1, then knit 2 stitches off of cable needle).
Cross $3 \mathrm{R}=$ cross 3 stitches to the right (slip 1 stitch onto a cable needle, let cable needle hang in back of work, $k 2$, then purl the stitch off of cable needle).
Cross $2 \mathrm{~L}=$ cross 2 stitches to the left (slip 1 stitch onto a cable needle, let cable needle hang in front of work, k1, knit the stitch off of cable needle).
Cross $2 \mathrm{R}=$ cross 2 stitches to the right (slip 1 stitch onto a cable needle, let cable needle hang in back of work, k1, knit the stitch off of cable needle).

## NOTES

Work the garment bottom-up in one piece, until reaching the armoholes. Divide in 2 parts and continue working separately up to the shoulders, which you will join in graft st. using the darning needle. Work the opening edges at the same time as the 2 fronts. Then work in round the sleeves around the armholes.

The instructions below refer to sizes $S(M-L)$, where the number before the parentheses corresponds to size $S$, while the numbers into the parentheses refer to sizes M-L.

SIZES: S (M-L)

## MEASURES OF GARMENT

Size shown by the picture: $S$
Chest circumference: 38 " $/ 96 \mathrm{~cm}$
Total height: $20 " / 51 \mathrm{~cm}$
Height from undersleeve: 12 " $/ 31 \mathrm{~cm}$
Circumference of top part of sleeve: $161 / 2 \mathrm{Z} / 42 \mathrm{~cm}$
Length from undersleeve: 17 "/43cm

## STITCHES USED

Patterned rib 2/2. Stocking stitch in back-and-forth rows. Stocking stitch in rounds.

## INSTRUCTIONS

## FRONT AND BACK UNTIL THE ARMHOLES

Using circular needles with size US6/4mm points and $32 " / 80 \mathrm{~cm}$ cable, cast-on 264 (272-280) sts. and work. 28 rows in patterned rib 2/2 as follow:
1st r. (RS): sl1 k-wise, k2 (p2, k2) rep. until 5 sts. from the end, p2, k3.
2nd r. (WS): sl1 p-wise, p2 (k2, p2) rep. until 5 sts. from the end, k2, p3.
From 3rd to 6th r.: rep. 1st and 2nd r.
7th r.: sl1 k-wise, k2, p2, (cross 3 L , cross $3 \mathrm{R}, \mathrm{p} 2$ ) rep. until 3 sts. from the end, k3.
8th r.: sl1 p-wise, p2, k3, (p4, k4) rep. until 10 sts. from the end, p4, k3, p3.
9th r.: sl1 k-wise, k2, p3, (cross 2 R, cross $2 \mathrm{~L}, \mathrm{p} 4$ ) rep. until
10 sts. from the end, cross 2 R, cross $2 \mathrm{~L}, \mathrm{p} 3, \mathrm{k} 3$.
10th r.: rep. the 8th r.
11th r.: sl1 k-wise, k2, p3, (cross 2 L , cross $2 \mathrm{R}, \mathrm{p} 4$ ) rep. until 10 sts. from the end, cross 2 L , cross $2 \mathrm{R}, \mathrm{p} 3$, k3.
12th r.: rep. the 8th r.
13th r.: sl1 k-wise, k2, p2, (cross 3 R, cross $3 \mathrm{~L}, \mathrm{p} 2$ ) rep. until 3 sts. from the end, k3.
14th r.: sl1 p-wise, p2, (k2, p2) rep. until 5 sts. from the end, k2, p3.
15th r.: sl1 k-wise, k2, (p2, k2) rep. until 5 sts. from the end, p2, k3.
16th and 17th r.: rep. 14th and 15th r.
18th r.: rep. the 14th r.
From 19th to 28th r.: rep. from 7th to 16th round.
Set out the working placing 1 SM as foll.:
For size S: 2144 sts. for the right front, 1 SM, 134 sts. for the back, 1 SM, 4421 for the left front.
For size M: 2146 sts. for the right front, 1 SM, 138 sts. for the back, 1 SM, 4621 for the left front.
For size L: 2148 sts. for the right front, 1 SM, 142 sts. for the back, 1 SM, 4821 for the left front.
Cont. as foll.:
1st r.: sl1 k-wise, k2, (p2, k2) 4 times, p2, knit until 10 sts. before the SM, k2tog, k8, move the SM, k8 k2tog, turn.
2nd r.: p17, p2tog, p8, turn.
3rd r.: k25., k2tog, k8, turn.
4th r.: p33, p2tog, p8, turn.
5th r.: k41, k2tog, k8, turn.
6th r.: p49, p2tog, p8, turn.
7th r.: k57, k2tog, k8, turn.
8th r.: p65, p2tog, p8, turn.

9th r.: k73, k2tog, k8, turn.
10th r.: p81, p2tog, p8, turn.
11th r.: k89, k2tog, k8, turn.
12th r.: p97, p2tog, p8, turn.
13th r.: k105, k2tog, k8, turn.
14th r.: p113, p2tog, p8, turn.
15th r.: k121, k2tog, k8, turn.
16th r.: p129, p2tog, p8, turn.
17th r.: k137, k2tog, k8, turn.
18th r.: p145, p2tog, p8, turn.
19th r.: k153, k2tog, k8, turn.
20th r.: p161, p2tog, p8, turn.
21st r.: k169, k2tog, k8, turn.
22nd r.: p177, p2tog, p8, turn.
23rd r.: k185, k2tog, knit until 21 sts. from the end, p2, (k2, p2) rep. until 5 sts. from the end, k2, p3 turn.
24th r.: sl1 p-wise, p2, (k2, p2) 5 times, purl until 21 sts. from the end, (p2, k2) 4 times, p3 [240 (248-256)]
Cont. as foll.:
25th r.: sl1 k-wise, k2, p2, (cross 3 L , cross 3 R, p2) twice, knit until 21 sts. from the end, p2, (cross 3 L , cross $3 \mathrm{R}, \mathrm{p} 2$ ) twice, k3.
26th r.: sl1 p-wise, p2, k3, p4, k4, p4, k3, purl until 21 sts. from the end, $k 3, p 4, k 4, p 4, k 3, p 3$.
27th r.: sl1 k-wise, k2, p3, cross 2 R, cross 2 L , p4, cross 2 R, cross 2 L , p3, knit until 21 sts. from the end, p3, cross $2 R$, cross 2 L , p4, cross 2 R , cross $2 \mathrm{~L}, \mathrm{p} 3$, k3.
28th r.: sl1 p-wise, p2, k3, p4, k4, p4, k3, purl until 21 sts. from the end, $k 3, p 4, k 4, p 4, k 3, p 3$.
29th r.: sl1 k-wise, k2, p3, cross 2 L , cross 2 R, p4, cross 2 L , cross 2 R, lav. a dir. until 21 sts. from the end, p3, cross 2 L , cross 2 R, p4, cross 2 L, cross 2 R, p3, k3.
30th r.: like 28th r.
31st r.: sl1 k-wise, k2, p2, (cross 3 L, cross 3 R, p2) per twice, knit until 21 sts. from the end, p2, (cross 3 L , cross $3 \mathrm{R}, \mathrm{p} 2$ ) per twice, k3.
32nd r.: sl1 p-wise, p2, (k2, p2) per 4 times, k2, purl until 21 sts. from the end, k2, (p2, k2) 4 times, p3.
33rd r.: sl1 k-wise, k2, (p2, k2) per 4 times, p2, knit until 21
sts. from the end, (p2, k2) 4 times, p2, k3.
34th r.: sl1 p-wise, p2, (k2, p2) per 4 times, k2, purl until 21 sts. from the end, k2, (p2, k2) 4 times, p3.
35th and 36th r.: like 33rd and 34th r.
Rep. from 25 th to 36 th r. until the end of 80 (84-88) r. or until needed length; at the same time decr. 1 st. (from the ribbed edge) every 8 r., beg. from 37th r.
At 81 (85-89) r. divide the panel in 3 pieces as foll.:
For size S: 2138 sts. for the right front, 1 SM, 110 sts. for the back, 1 SM, 3821 for the left front.
For size M: 2140 sts. for the right front, 1 SM, 114 sts. for the back, 1 SM, 4021 for the left front.
For size L: 2142 sts. for the right front, 1 SM, 118 sts. for the back, 1 SM, 4221 for the left front.
Cont. working 3 pieces separately, foll. the settings of bands and fronts decreases, then work as foll.:
RIGHT FRONT
Row 81 (85-89): 21 sts. for the band (like set out), knit until the end of $r$.

Row 82 (86-90): purl until 21 sts. from the end, 21 sts. for the band (like set out).
Rep. the row 81 (85-89) and row 82 (86-90) until the end of row 142 (146-150).
Leave the sts. of front and cont. working only the sts. of the band, as length as half of back neckline, then leave these sts. too.
BACK
Row 81 (85-89): knit until the end of $r$.
Row 82 (86-90): purl until the end of $r$.
Rep. the row 81 (85-89) and the row $82(86-90)$ until the end of row 142 (146-150), then leave the sts.

## LEFT FRONT

Row 81 (85-89): knit until 21 sts. from the end, 21 sts. for the band, like set out.
Row 82 (86-90): 21 sts. for the band, like set out, purl until the end of $r$.
Rep. the row 81 (85-89) and row 82 (86-90) until the end of row 142 (146-150).
Leave the sts. of the front and cont. working only the sts. of the band, as length as half of back neckline, then leave these sts. too.

## SHOULDERS AND COLLAR FINISHING

Join the stitches of the shoulders (front and back) you have left.
Join the stitches of the band in graft st., shaping a single band (closed at back center), then sew the band on back neckline.

## SLEEVES

Using size US6/4mm points and 40 cm cable, pick-up 100 sts. around the armhole. Close in round and place the SMb in the center of undersleeve.
1st round: knit until SMb.
From round 2 to round 100 (106-112): rep. the 1st round, incr. 12 sts. across last round, uniformly.
Cont. working the band (cuff) in patterned rib $2 / 2$ as foll.:
From 1st to 4th round: p1 (k2, p2) rep. until 3 sts. before the SMb, k2, p1.
5th round: p1, (cross 3 L , cross 3 R, p2) rep. until 7 sts. before the SMb , cross 3 L , cross 3 R , p 1 .
6th round: p2, (k4, p4) rep. until 6 sts. prima del MG, k4, p2. 7th round: p2, (cross 2 R, cross $2 \mathrm{~L}, \mathrm{p} 4$ ) rep. until 6 sts. before the SMb, cross 2 R , cross $2 \mathrm{~L}, \mathrm{p} 2$.
8th round: like 6th round.
9th round: p2, (cross 2 L , cross $2 \mathrm{R}, \mathrm{p} 4$ ) rep. until 6 sts. before the SMb , cross 2 L , cross $2 \mathrm{R}, \mathrm{p} 2$
10th round: like 6th round.
11th round: p1, (cross 3 R , cross 3 L , p2) rep. until 7 sts. before the SMb , cross 3 R , cross 3 L , p 1 .
From 12th to 16th round: p1, (k2, p2) rep. until 3 sts. before the SMb, k2, p1.
Rep. from 5th to 16th round, then bind off all sts. loosely. FINISHING
Hide the ends. Wet and block.
