



# THE COLOR EVOLUTION



## SHAWL

### MATERIAL

Poema Stripes by Laines du Nord: 1 x 150g ball in the colour of your choice (col. 02 shown)  
Knitting needles size US7/4.5 mm  
Large eye darning needle  
Scissors  
Tape measure

### GAUGE

19sts and 24 rows = 4"/10cm square over stocking stitch using size US7/4.5mm knitting needles.

### ABBREVIATIONS

RS = right side of work  
WS = wrong side of work  
st/sts = stitch / stitches  
k = knit  
r = row / rows  
incr = increase  
decr = decrease  
rep = repeat / repeating  
p = purl  
cont = continue / continuing  
foll= follow / following  
NR = next row

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy

### MEASUREMENTS

Spine: 17"/43cm  
Wingspan: 150"/381cm

### STITCHES USED

Stocking stich (RS knit, WS purl)

### NOTES

Work the shawl from one side tip to the opposite one. Increase across the first piece of the shawl (up to half the ball), then decrease across the second piece, using up the entire ball.

**Sample in photo is machine made so the K1, P1, rib on the edge looks slightly different but instructions are correct to match a handknit K1, P1 rib.**

## INSTRUCTIONS

Using size US7/4.5mm knitting needles, cast-on 12 sts. and work patt as follows:

**1st r. (WS):** purl to end.

**2nd r. (RS):** \* K1, P1, rep from \* to end.

**3rd r.:** As row 2.

**4th r.:** As row 2.

**5th r.:** Purl into front and back of the first stitch, rib as set to end.

**6th r.:** Rib as set 12 sts, K1.

**7th r.:** Purl into front and back of the first stitch, rib as set to end.

**8th r.:** Rib as set 12 sts, K2.

**9th r.:** Purl into front and back of the first stitch, purl to the last 12sts, rib as set to end.

**10th r.:** Rib as set 12 sts, Knit to end

Cont working the 12 sts in rib **AT THE SAME TIME** inc 1 st at the beg of every wrong row working the inc sts into stocking stitch, cont until you have worked half the ball of yarn ending with a WS row.

Cont working rib over the 12 sts **AT THE SAME TIME** dec 1 st at the beg of every wrong side row until 12sts rem ending with a WS row.

Rib 4 rows.

Cast off.
