OVERVIEW

Short Chanel-style jewel neck cardigan. Yoke is worked from the top down, with raglan shaping and German short-row shaping for the back neck. Sleeves are divided from yoke and placed on hold while body is worked to the hem. Then sleeves are worked in the round to the cuff. Entire piece is worked in Stockinette stitch, exclusive of trim.

Small lined knit purse with fold-over button flap and metal chain strap.

SIZES

JACKET

Small (Medium, Large, X-Large, XX-Large, XXX-Large)

To fit bust: 32 (36, 40, 44, 48, 52)in / 81.5 (91.5, 101.5, 112, 122, 132)cm.

Positive Ease: 4-6in (10-15cm).

PURSE

One size.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

JACKET

Bust, buttoned: 36½ (41, 45½, 49½, 54, 58)in/92.5 (104, 115.5, 125.5, 137, 147.5)cm.

Length: 21½ (22, 22½, 23¼, 23½, 24)in/54.5 (56, 57, 59, 59.5, 61)cm.

PURSE

Width: 7¼in (18.5cm).

Length: 7½in (19cm).

JACKET

Juniper Moon Farm **MOONSHINE FINE**

A color 1029 Antique Bronze 2 (3, 3, 3, 3) x 100g

PURSE

Juniper Moon Farm **MOONSHINE FINE**

A color 1001 Cocoa 1 x 100g

B color 05 Chocolate Cosmo 1 x 20g

Moda Fibre Co. **ARA (C549)**

C color 01 Anise 1 x 50g

NEEDLES + NOTIONS

Size US 9 (5.5mm) 32-40in (80-100cm) circular needle and dpns, for body and sleeves.

Size US 7 (4.5mm) 32-40in (80-100cm) circular needle and dpns, for hem, cuffs, neckband, and front bands.

Size US 8 (5mm) needles for purse.

Stitch markers.

Stitch holders or waste yarn.

7 buttons, ¾in (19mm).

1 button, ¾" (19mm) for purse.

Crochet hook size US H (5 mm) for purse.

¼ yard (23cm) of matching woven cotton fabric for lining.

Matching sewing thread.

Metal chain for strap -approx 24in (60cm) or desired length.

GAUGE

JACKET

15 sts and 20 rows = 4in (10cm) in Stockinette stitch, using larger needle and 1 strand each of **A**, **B**, and **C** held together.

PURSE

15 sts and 20 rows = 4in (10cm) in Stockinette stitch in stripe pattern. **Change needle size if necessary to obtain the correct gauge.**

ABBREVIATIONS

beg: begin(ning)(s); **BO:** bind off; **BOR:** beginning of round; **CO:** cast on; **cont:** continu(e)(es)(ing); **dec:** decreas(e)(es)(ing); **dpn(s):** double-pointed needle(s); **inc:** increase(e)(es)(ing); **k:** knit; **p:** purl; **patt:** pattern(s); **pm:** place marker; **rem:** remain(ing)(s); **rep:** repeat(ing)(s); **RS:** right side; **sm:** slip marker; **st(s):** stitch(es); **St st:** Stockinette stitch; **tog:** together; **WS:** wrong side; **yo:** yarn over.

STITCH GLOSSARY

DS: Double Stitch (see German Short Rows).

MiL (make one left): Insert left needle tip from front to back under strand between last st worked and next st and knit strand through the back loop.

MiLP (make one left purlwise): Insert left needle tip from front to back under strand between last st worked and next st and purl strand through the back loop.

MiR (make one right): Insert left needle tip from back to front under strand between last st worked and next st and knit strand through the front loop.

MiRP (make one right purlwise): Insert left needle tip from back to front under strand between last st worked and next st and purl strand through the front loop.

ssk: Slip 2 sts one at a time knitwise, insert left needle into these 2 sts and knit them together through the back loops.

CARDIGAN

YARN PAIRINGS

Color 1: Work with 1 strand each of **A**, **B**, and **C** held together.

Color 2: Work with 1 strand each of **A** and **D** held together.

1X1 RIB (odd number of sts)

Row 1 (RS): *K1, p1; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 2 (WS): *P1, k1; rep from * to last st, p1.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 for patt.

YOKE

Using smaller needle and Color 2, CO 67 (71, 75, 75, 79, 79) sts.

Beg 1x1 Rib; work 5 rows even.

Set-Up Row (WS): Cont in 1x1 Rib, work 11 (12, 13, 13, 14, 14) sts, pm for right front, work 2 sts, pm for right front raglan, work 6 sts, pm for right sleeve, work 2 sts, pm for right back raglan, work 23 (25, 27, 27, 29, 29) sts, k2tog, pm for back, work 2 sts, pm for left back raglan, work 6 sts, pm for left sleeve, work 2 sts, pm for left

front raglan, work 11 (12, 13, 13, 14, 14) sts for left front—66 (70, 74, 74, 78, 78) sts rem.

Change to larger needle and Color 1.

Beg St st.

Shape neck and raglan

Note: Neck is shaped using German short rows.

Short Row 1 (RS): * [Knit to marker, M1R, sm, k2, sm, M1L] 4 times, k3, turn—74 (78, 82, 82, 86, 86) sts.

Short Row 2 (WS): DS, purl to last marker, sm, p3, turn.

Short Row 3: DS, knit to marker, [M1R, sm, k2, sm, M1L] 4 times, knit to next DS, close DS, k3, turn—8 sts inc'd.

Short Row 4: DS, purl to next DS, close DS, p3, turn.

Short Rows 5-8: Rep Short Rows 3 and 4 twice—98 (102, 106, 106, 110, 110) sts.

Short Row 9: DS, knit to marker, [M1R, sm, k2, sm, M1L] 4 times, knit to next DS, close DS, knit to end—106 (110, 114, 114, 118, 118) sts; 34 (36, 38, 38, 40, 40) sts for back, 16 (17, 18, 18, 19, 19) sts each front, 16 sts each sleeve, and 2 sts each raglan column.

Row 10: Purl to DS, close DS, purl to end.

Shape raglan

Size Small Only

Raglan Inc Row (RS): [Knit to marker, M1R, sm, k2, sm, M1L] 4 times, knit to end—8 sts inc'd.

Sleeve WS Inc Row (WS): [Purl to marker, sm, p2, sm, M1LP, purl to marker, M1RP, sm, p2, sm] twice, purl to end—4 sts inc'd.

Rep Raglan Inc Row every RS row 3 times—24 sts inc'd.

Work 1 WS row even.

Rep the last 8 rows 2 more times, then rep Raglan Inc Row once more—222 sts.

Work 1 WS row even.

Sleeve RS Inc Row (RS): [Knit to marker, sm, k2, sm, M1L, knit to marker, M1R, sm, k2, sm] twice, knit to end—226 sts; 60 sts for back, 29 sts each front, 50 sts each sleeve, and 2 sts each raglan column.

Work 1 WS row even.

Size Medium Only

Raglan Inc Row (RS): [Knit to marker, M1R, sm, k2, sm, M1L] 4 times, knit to end—8 sts inc'd.

Sleeve WS Inc Row (WS): [Purl to marker, sm, p2, sm, M1LP, purl to marker, M1RP, sm, p2, sm] twice, purl to end—4 sts inc'd.

Rep Raglan Inc Row every RS row 6 times—48 sts inc'd.

Work 1 WS row even.

Rep the last 14 rows once more—230 sts.

Work 1 WS row even.

Sleeve RS Inc Row (RS): [Knit to marker, sm, k2, sm, M1L, knit to marker, M1R, sm, k2, sm] twice, knit to end—234 sts; 64 sts for back, 31 sts each front, 50 sts each sleeve, and 2 sts each raglan column.

Work 1 WS row even.

Size Large Only

Raglan Inc Row (RS): [Knit to marker, M1R, sm, k2, sm, M1L] 4 times, knit to end—8 sts inc'd.

Rep Raglan Inc Row every RS row 14 more times—234 sts.

Work 1 WS row even.

Sleeve RS Inc Row (RS): [Knit to marker, sm, k2, sm, M1L, knit to marker, M1R, sm, k2, sm] twice, knit to end—238 sts; 68 sts for back, 33 sts each front, 48 sts each sleeve, and 2 sts each raglan column.

Work 1 WS row even.

Sizes X-Large and 2X-Large Only

Raglan Inc Row (RS): [Knit to marker, M1R, sm, k2, sm, M1L] 4 times, knit to end—8 sts inc'd.

Rep Raglan Inc Row every RS row – (–, –, 14, 13, –) more times – (–, –, 234, 230, –) sts.

Work 1 WS row even.

Body Inc Row (RS): [Knit to marker, M1R, sm, k2, sm, knit to marker, sm, k2, sm, M1L] 4 times, knit to end—4 sts inc'd.

Work 1 WS row even.

Rep Raglan Inc Row once more—8 sts inc'd.

Work 1 WS row even.

Rep the last 4 rows – (–, –, 0, 1, –) more time(s) – (–, –, 246, 254, –) sts; – (–, –, 72, 76, –) sts for back, – (–, –, 35, 37, –) sts each front, 48 sts each sleeve, and 2 sts each raglan column.

Work 2 rows even.

Size 3X-Large Only

Raglan Inc Row (RS): [Knit to marker, M1R, sm, k2, sm, M1L] 4 times, knit to end—8 sts inc'd.

Rep Raglan Inc Row every RS row 10 more times—206 sts.

Work 1 row even.

Rep Raglan Inc Row once—8 sts inc'd.

Work 1 row even.

Body Inc Row (RS): [Knit to marker, M1R, sm, k2, sm, knit to marker, sm, k2, sm, M1L] 4 times, knit to end—4 sts inc'd.

Work 1 row even.

Rep the last 4 rows 3 more times—254 sts; 78 sts for back, 38 sts each front, 46 sts each sleeve, and 2 sts each raglan column.

Work 2 rows even.

All Sizes

DIVIDE FOR BODY AND SLEEVES

Note: One st from each raglan column will go to the sleeves, and one to the back/fronts.

Division Row (RS): Cont in patt as established and removing markers as you come to them, k30 (32, 34, 36, 38, 39), transfer next 52 (52, 50, 50, 50, 48) sts to st holder or waste yarn for left sleeve, CO 6 (10, 14, 18, 22, 28) sts for underarm, k62 (66, 70, 74, 78, 80), transfer next 52 (52, 50, 50, 50, 48) sts to st holder or waste yarn for right sleeve, CO 6 (10, 14, 18, 22, 28) sts for underarm, knit to end—134 (150, 166, 182, 198, 214) sts rem.

BODY

Work even until piece measures 11in (28cm) from underarm, ending with a WS row, and inc 1 st on final row—135 (151, 167, 183, 199, 215) sts.

Change to smaller needle and Color 2.

Beg 1x1 Rib; work 6 rows even. BO all sts in patt.

SLEEVE

With RS facing, using larger dpns and Color 1, and beg at center underarm, pick up and knit 3 (5, 7, 9, 11, 14) sts from last half of body underarm CO, knit across 52 (52, 50, 50, 50, 48) sts from st holder or waste yarn, pick up and knit 3 (5, 7, 9, 11, 14) sts from first half of body underarm CO—58 (62, 64, 68, 72, 76) sts. Join for working in the round; pm for BOR.

Beg St st (knit every round); work 1½in even.

Shape sleeve

Dec Round: K1, ssk, knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1—2 sts dec'd.

Rep Dec Round every 6th round 10 (9, 8, 7, 3, 3) more times, then every 4th round 0 (2, 4, 6, 12, 13) times—36 (38, 38, 40, 40, 42) sts rem.

Work even until piece measures 14½ (15, 15½, 15¾, 16, 16½)in/ 37 (38, 39.5, 40, 40.5, 42)cm from underarm.

Change to smaller dpns and Color 2.

Beg 1x1 Rib; work 1in/2.5cm even. BO all sts in patt.

FINISHING

Block piece to measurements.

Button Band

With RS facing, using smaller needle and Color 2, pick up and knit 81 (81, 83, 87, 87, 89) sts along left front, beg at top of yoke.

Beg 1x1 Rib; work 6 rows even. BO all sts in patt.

Buttonhole Band

With RS facing, using smaller needle and Color 2, pick up and knit 81 (81, 83, 87, 87, 89) sts along right front, ending at top of yoke.

Beg 1x1 Rib; work 2 rows

Buttonhole Row (WS): Work 4 (4, 5, 4, 4, 5) sts in patt, *BO 2 sts (1 st rem on right needle after BO), work 9 (9, 9, 10, 10, 10) sts in patt; rep from * to last 5 (5, 6, 5, 5, 6) sts, BO 2 sts, work in patt to end.

Next Row (RS): Work to end, CO 2 sts over BO sts from previous row.

Work 2 rows even. BO in patt.

Sew buttons opposite buttonholes.

PURSE

STRIPE PATTERN

Working in St st, *work 2 rows in B + C held together, then work garter st for 2 rows in A (held doubled)*. Rep *to* for pattern.

ONE PIECE

Using 1 strand each of A and B held tog, CO 30 sts. Work in stripe pattern till piece measures 7.5 in (19cm).

Place marker for bottom turn row.

Continue in stripe pat till piece measures 15in (38cm).

Place marker to indicate beg of flap.

Then BO 4 sts at beg of next 6 rows to shape flap. BO center 6 sts.

Using 2 strands of A held tog, pick up and knit 12 sts for left side of flap, 6 sts for center and 12 sts for right side of flap. Knit 4 rows, then BO 30 sts.

CROCHET TRIM

Using crochet hook and two strands of A held tog, work 1 row of slip st crochet along BO edge of flap. Then work one row, working 2 unattached chains in center of flap for buttonhole, and reattach to finish the row. Weave in all ends.

FINISHING

Steam block purse to measurements.

Sew sides of purse tog, allowing flap to fold over front edge.

LINING

Cut fabric for lining according to measurements.



Sew ¼in (0.5cm) side seams with right sides together leaving ½in (1.3cm) at top to be folded under.

Insert lining into knit purse.

Using whip stitch, tack lining by hand to top edge of knit purse, sewing loosely to allow for stretch in the knit fabric and lining up the side seams. Turn under ½in (1.3cm) of fabric to inside to hide raw edge of lining.

Cut metal chain to 24in (60cm) or desired length. Sew to top edge inside of purse (not flap) securely.

Sew button to front of purse for closure.
