

THE COLOR EVOLUTION



SCARF

MATERIAL

1 ball col. 02 of Piuma Alpaca Degradé by Laines du Nord (A). 1 ball col. 09 of Piuma Alpaca Degradé by Laines du Nord (B). Size US11/8 mm knitting needles. Darning needle.

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit
p = purl
rep = repeat
RS = right side
st(s) = stitch(es)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width 13"/33cm Length 85"/215cm

TENSION

 $10\frac{1}{2}$ sts and 18 rows = 10 x 10 cm (4 x 4") square over stocking stitch using size US11/8mm knitting needles.

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Break off 260"/660cm from shade A. This will be used for the fringing along the cast on row.

Using size US11/8 mm knitting needles and shade A, cast on 34 sts and work as follows:

Row 1 (RS): Knit to end.

Row 2: Purl to end.

Rep the last 2 rows for a further 12 rows.

Change to shade B

Row 15: Knit to end.

Row 16: Purl to end.

Rep the last 2 rows for a further 12 rows. (28 rows worked) Rep these 28 rows until scarf measures $85^{\circ\prime}/215$ cm approx. ending with 14 rows of shade B.

Cast off.

FRINGES

Thread the yarn through darning needle draw up half way and knot ends to secure.

Twisting the yarn as you go and working across the cast on row thread through at equal intervals leaving a drop of 6"/15cm.

Rep on the cast off row.
