



THE COLOR EVOLUTION



SHAWL

SKILL LEVEL: Intermediate

MATERIALS

Cotton Lux by Laines du Nord approx. 3 x 100 grams x col. 04
Size US4/3.5mm (100cm long) circular needles

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length (approx.): 106"/270cm

Right side length (approx.): 49"/125cm

Left side length (approx.): 82"/210cm

GAUGE

10 x 10 cm = 19sts and 25 rows in stockinette stitch using size US4/3.5mm needles.

It is very important to check your gauge and measure the tension correctly to achieve the same results and measurements as the pattern.

If the gauge is different, try adjusting the needle size up or down by half a size until you get the correct measurement.

ABBREVIATIONS

RS = right side of the work

WS = wrong side of the work

SM = stitch marker

col = color(s)

st(s) = stitch(es)

k = knit

p = purl

yo = yarn over

rep = repeat

M1L = Make 1 left leaning thus: pick up horizontal loop lying between last stitch worked and next stitch, place loop on left hand needle and knit through back of loop

M1R = Make 1 right leaning thus: pick up horizontal loop lying between last stitch worked and next stitch, place loop on left hand needle and knit this loop.

sl 1pwyib = slip 1 stitch purl-wise, with yarn in back of work.

sl 2pwyib = slip 2 stitches purl-wise, with yarn in back of work.

k2tog = knit 2 stitches together (insert the right needle through next 2 stitches on left needle and knit them together).

k3tog = knit 3 stitches together (insert the right needle through next 3 stitches on left needle and knit them together).

k3tog tbl = knit 3 stitches together (insert the right needle through the back loop of next 3 stitches on left needle and knit them together).

skpo = slip 1, knit 1, pass slipped st over (slip 1 st knit-wise, k1, pass slipped st over).

INSTRUCTIONS

Work the shawl in a single piece seamless. The pattern is created by the space-dyed yarn.

DETAILED PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

SECTION 1

Cast-on 3 sts.

Row 1 (WS): purl.

Row 2 (RS): k1, M1R, place SM, sl 1pwyib, place SM, M1L, k1.

Row 3: p2, SM, p1, SM, p2.

Row 4: sl 2pwyib, M1R, SM, sl 1pwyib, SM, M1L, sl 2pwyib.

Row 5: purl to end slipping marker.

Row 6: sl 2pwyib, knit until the marker, M1R, SM, sl 1pwyib, SM, M1L, knit until last 2sts, sl 2pwyib.

Row 7: As row 5.

Repeat rows 6 and 7, 22 times more.

Row 52 (RS): (sl 2pwyib, *k3, yo, k3tog tbl, yo, rep from * to marker, M1R, SM, sl 1pwyib, SM, M1L, ** yo, k3tog tbl, yo, k3, rep from ** until 2 sts from the end of the row, sl2pwyib.

Row 53: As row 5.

Row 54: sl 2pwyib, * yo, k3tog tbl, yo, k3, rep from * to marker, M1R, SM, sl 1pwyib, SM, M1L, work all sts reversing the shape of previous side until 2 sts from the end of the row, sl 2pwyib

Row 55: As row 5

Rep rows 6 and 7 eight times more.

SECTION 2

Row 1 (RS): sl 2pwyib, *k3, yo, k3tog tbl, yo, rep from * to marker, M1R, SM, sl 1pwyib, SM, M1L, work all sts reversing the shape of previous side until 2 sts from the end of the row, sl 2pwyib.

Row 2: purl to end slipping markers.

Row 3: sl 2pwyib, *yo, k3, yo, k3tog tbl, rep from * to marker, M1R, SM

sl 1pwyib, SM, M1L, work all sts reversing the shape of previous side until 2 sts from the end of the row, sl 2pwyib.

Row 4: As row 2.

Rep rows 1 to 4 once.

Row 5: sl 2pwyib, knit to marker, M1R, SM, sl 1pwyib, SM, M1L, knit until 2 sts from the end of the row, sl 2pwyib.

Row 6: As row 2

Row 7: sl 2pwyib, k2tog, knit to the marker, M1R, SM, sl 1pwyib, SM, M1L, knit until 4 sts from the end of the row, skpo, sl 2pwyib.

Row 8: As row 2

Rep rows 5 to 8, seven times.

Rep rows 1 to 4, three times.

Rep rows 5 to 8, ten times.

Rep rows 1 to 4, three times.

Rep rows 5 to 8, once.

Rep rows 1 to 4, three times.

Rep rows 5 to 8, ten times.

Rep rows 5 to 7, once.

On WS, bind off 88 sts in purl st until the SM; on right needle there is 1 st.

Remove the SM, bind off 1 st and remove the second SM.

Move the st from right to left needle P2tog, then purl until the end of the row.

SECTION 3

Row 1: sl 2pwyib, knit until 2 sts from the end of the row, sl 2pwyib.

Row 2: Purl to end.

Row 3: sl 2pwyib, k2tog, knit until 2 sts from the end of the row, sl 2pwyib.

Row 4: As row 2.

Rep rows 1 to 4, six times.

SECTION 4

Row 1: sl 2pwyib, k5, *yo, K3, yo, k3tog rep from * until 2 sts from the end of the row, sl 2pwyib.

Row 2: Purl to end.

Row 3: sl 2pwyib, k2tog, *yo, k3tog, yo, k3, rep from * until 2 sts from the end of the row, sl 2pwyib.

Row 4: As row 2.

Row 5: sl 2pwyib, knit until 2 sts from the end of the row, sl 2pwyib.

Row 6: As row 2.

Row 7: sl 2pwyib, K2tog, knit until 2 sts from the end of the row, sl 2pwyif.

Row 8: As row 2.

Rep rows 1 to 8, three times.

Rep rows 5 to 8, eleven times.

Rep rows 1 to 8, twice.

Rep rows 5 to 8, three times.

Rep rows 1 to 8, twice.

Rep rows 5 to 8, twenty times.

Rep rows 1 to 8, once.

SECTION 5

Repeat rows 5 to 8 until are 4 sts rem.

Next row: * K4sts, then pass the sts from right needle to left needle with yarn in back, with point of right hand needle pick up 1 st from side, place on left hand needle and pass the previous st over this one, rep from * around the entire shawl. Weave in all ends.
