

DESIGN 3

DOOR STOP

Measurements

13 x 13cm, 51/4 x 51/4in

Materials

100g of Araucania Panguipulli Shade 13 1 Pair of 6mm (US10) knitting needles Cable Needle

Weights and Stuffing

Tension

16sts and 22 rows to 10cm, 4in, over stocking stitch using 6mm (US10) knitting needles.

Special Abbreviations

C4B. Slip next 2sts onto CN and hold at back of work, K2 then K2 from CN.

For abbreviations see page 38

DOOR STOP

Stocking Stitch Squares (work 4 pieces)
Using 6mm (US10) needles cast on 20sts and work in st-st for 13cm, 51/4in, ending with a ws row.
Cast off.

Cable Squares (work 4 pieces)

Using 6mm (US10) needles cast on 26sts.

1st Row: P3, K4, (P4, K4) twice, P3. **2nd Row:** K3, (P4, K4) twice, P4, K3. **3rd Row:** P3, C4B, (P4, C4B) twice, P3. **4th Row:** K3, (P4, K4) twice, P4, K3.

1st to 4th row sets patt.


Keeping continuity of patt as set (throughout) cont until work measures 13cm, 5¼in, ending with a ws row.

Cast off in patt.

Loop

Using 6mm (US10) needles cast on 32sts and knit 3 rows.


Cast off knitways.



To Complete

Join 3 sides of 2 st-st squares together and fill with pebbles or something with weight. Join side edges of cabled squares together to form sides of square. Sew a stocking stitch square to lower part of cabled sides. Sew remaining stocking stitch square to top and join 3 sides. Insert weight bag and stuff remainder of Door Stop. Join rem st-st top seam. Fold loop in half and attach to top of square. See ball band for care instructions.
