TEA COSY AND EGG COSY

Measurements

TEA COSY

Width around widest Part

cm 46 54

in 18 21¼

Depth from lower edge to centre of Top (approximately)

cm 22 27

in 8¾ 10¾

EGG COSY

Width all Round

cm 13

in 5¼

Materials

100g of Araucania Aysen Shade 828 for both Tea Cosy and Egg Cosy

1 Pair of 5.5mm (US9) knitting needles

Cable Needle

Stitch Holder for Tea Cosy

Tension

16sts and 22 rows to 10cm, 4in, over pattern when stretched using 5.5mm (US9) knitting needles.

Special Abbreviations

C6B. Slip next 3sts onto a CN and hold at back of work, K3 then K3 from CN.

C2B. Slip next st onto a CN and hold at back of work, K1 then K1 from CN.

For abbreviations see page 38

TEA COSY

Using 5.5mm (US9) needles cast 74 [86]sts and work 3 rows in g-st.

Next Row: K6 [7], m1, K2, m1, (K10 [12], m1, K2, m1) 5 times, K6 [7]. 86 [98]sts.

Proceed as follows:-

1st Row: P5 [6], K6, (P8 [10], K6) 5 times, P5 [6].

2nd Row: K5 [6], (P6, K8 [10]) 5 times, P6, K5 [6]

3rd Row: P5 [6], C6B, (P8 [10], C6B) 5 times, P5 [6].

4th Row: As 2nd row.



5th Row: As 1st row.

6th Row: K5 [6], (P6, K8 [10]) 5 times, P6, K5 [6].

1st to 6th row sets rev st-st and cable patt.

Keeping continuity of patt as set work 4 [8] rows more.

Divide For Spout

Next Row: Patt43 [49], turn, leave rem 43 [49]sts on a stitch holder.

Working on these 43 [49]sts only proceed as follows:-

Next Row: K2, patt to end.

Next Row: Patt to last 2sts, K2.

Rep last 2 rows 5 [7] times more.

Leave these 43 [49]sts on a stitch holder.

With rs facing, rejoin yarn to 43 [49]sts at commencement of Spout Opening and patt to end.

Next Row: Patt to last 2sts, K2.

Next Row: K2, patt to end.

Rep last 2 rows 5 [7] times more.

Next Row: K5 [6], (patt6, K8 [10]) twice, patt6, K4 [5], patt across 43 [49]sts left on a stitch holder as follows:- K4 [5], patt6, (K8 [10], patt6) twice, K5 [6].

Work 4 rows more without shaping.

Shape Top

For Large size only

1st Row: P4, P2tog, patt6, (P2tog, P6, P2tog, patt6) 5 times, P2tog, P4. 86sts.

2nd Row: K5, (patt6, K8) 5 times, patt6, K5.

3rd Row: P5, patt6, (P8, patt6) 5 times, P5.

4th Row: As 2nd row.

For Both sizes

1st Row: P3, P2tog, patt6, (P2tog, P4, P2tog, patt6) 5 times, P2tog, P3. 74sts.

2nd Row: K4, (patt6, K6) 5 times, patt6, K4.

3rd Row: P4, patt6, (P6, patt6) 5 times, P4.

4th Row: As 2nd row.

5th Row: P2, P2tog, patt6, (P2tog, P2, P2tog, patt6) 5 times, P2tog, P2. 62sts.

6th Row: K3, (patt6, K4) 5 times, patt6, K3.

7th Row: P3, patt6, (P4, patt6) 5 times, P3.

8th Row: As 6th row.

9th Row: P1, P2tog, patt6, * (P2tog) twice, patt6 * rep from * to * 4 times, P2tog, P1. 50sts.

10th Row: K2, (patt6, K2) 6 times.

11th Row: (P2, patt6) 6 times, P2.

12th Row: As 10th row.

13th Row: P2, * (K2tog) 3 times, P2, rep from * to end. 32sts.

14th Row: K2, * P3tog, K2, rep from * to end. 20sts. Break off yarn, thread yarn through rem sts, draw up and fasten off.

Top Loop

Using 5.5mm (US9) needles cast on 24sts and work 3 rows in g-st.

Cast off knitways.

To Complete

Join back seam for 8cm, 3in, Leave 10cm, 4in, free for handle, sew remainder of back seam. Fold Loop in half and attach to centre at top of Cosy. See ball band for care instructions.

EGG COSY

Using 5.5mm (US9) needles cast on 22sts and knit 1 row.

Next Row: K4, m1, (K5, m1) 3 times, K3. 26sts.

Proceed as follow:-

1st Row: P3, C2B, (P4, C2B) 3 times, P3.

2nd Row: K3, (P2, K4) 3 times, P2, K3.

1st and 2nd rows set patt.

Work 10 rows more in patt.

Proceed as follows:

1st Row: P1, P2tog, C2B, (P1, P2tog, P1, C2B) 3 times, P2tog, P1. 21sts.

2nd Row: K2, (P2, K3) 3 times, P2, K2.

3rd Row: P2, C2B, (P2tog, P1, C2B) 3 times, P2. 18sts.

4th Row: K2, (P2, K2) 4 times.

5th Row: (P2tog, K2tog) 4 times, P2tog. 9sts.

Break off yarn, thread yarn through rem sts, draw up and fasten off.

Top Loop

Using 5.5mm (US9) needles cast on 16sts and knit 1 row.

Cast off knitways.

To Complete

Join back seam. Fold Loop in half and attach to centre at top of Egg Cosy. See ball band for care instructions.
