Yarn

2 colour tunic

Photographed knitted in Fleuris (1st size photographed)

A. sh. 14 Kiss 8

10 x 50g balls

B. sh. 18 Bouquet

x 50g balls

One colour tunic

Photographed knitted in Fleuris, sh. 19 Hedgerow (1st size photographed) 12 16 x 50g balls

Needles

Pair of 5.5 mm (US 9) knitting needles Pair of 6 mm (US 10) knitting needles

Tension/gauge

13 sts x 20 rows to 10 cm (4 in) square measured over edging patt using 6 mm (US 10) knitting needles.
16 sts x 20 rows to 10 cm (4 in) square

measured over st st using 6 mm (US 10) knitting needles.

Note: This garment is knitted side to side with the number of patt reps given for the 1st size first with the 2nd size in **(bold)**.

Special abbreviation: SSK – slip 2 sts knitwise one at a time from the LH needle to the RH needle, insert LH needle tip through both front loops and knit together.

2 colour tunic

Back and front (work both the same) Using 5.5 mm (US 9) needles and yarn A cast on 70 sts, change to yarn B and cast on 28 sts. (98 sts)

Edging row 1: K28 sts yarn B, twist yarns around each other on WS to stop a hole forming, K70 sts yarn A.

Edging row 2: K70 sts yarn A, twist yarns around each other on WS to stop a hole forming, K28 sts yarn B.

Edging row 3 (picot): Cast on 2 sts, cast off 2 sts (1 st on RH needle), K27 sts yarn B, twist yarns around each other on WS to stop a hole forming, K70 sts yarn A. Edging row 4: K70 sts yarn A, twist yarns around each other on WS to stop a hole forming, K28 sts yarn B.


Change to 6 mm (US 10) needles and work 28 rows in heart lace edge patt in yarn B and main body in yarn A using



Making up

Press/block as on information page. Join front and back top edging to make shoulder seams, leaving 28 cm (11 in) open for neck.

Measure 28 cm down from shoulder seam, join side seams using mattress stitch or back stitch to start of heart lace edging.

the intarsia method of twisting yarns on WS to prevent a hole forming, setting sts as folls:

Patt row 1 (RS): K9, (yo, SSK) twice, K3, (K2tog, yo) twice, K8 yarn B, K70 yarn A. Patt row 2 and every WS row: K6, P64 yarn A, K2, P22, K4 yarn B.

Patt row 3 (picot): Cast on 2 sts, cast off 2 sts (1 st on RH needle), K6, (K2tog, yo) twice, K4, (K2tog, yo) twice, K1, yo, SSK, K6 yarn B, K70 yarn A.

Patt row 5: K6, (K2tog, yo) twice, K4, (K2tog, yo) twice, K1, (yo, SSK) twice, K5 yarn B, K70 yarn A.

Patt row 7 (picot): Cast on 2 sts, cast off 2 sts (1 st on RH needle), K4, (K2tog, yo) twice, K4, (K2tog, yo) twice, K3, (yo, SSK) twice, K4 yarn B, K70 yarn A. Patt row 9: K7, (yo, SSK) twice, K1, (K2tog, yo) twice, K5, (yo, SSK) twice, K3 yarn B, K70 yarn A.

Patt row 11 (picot): Cast on 2 sts, cast off 2 sts (1 st on RH needle), K7, yo, SSK, yo, sl1, K2tog, psso, yo, K2tog, yo, K4, (K2tog, yo) twice, K5 yarn B, K70 yarn A. Patt row 13: K9, yo, SSK, yo, sl1, K2tog, psso, yo, K4, (K2tog, yo) twice, K6 yarn B, K70 yarn A.

Patt row 15 (picot): Cast on 2 sts, cast off 2 sts (1 st on RH needle), K9, (yo, SSK) twice, K3, (K2tog, yo) twice, K7 yarn B, K70 yarn A.

Patt row 17: K8, K2tog, yo, K1, (yo, SSK) twice, K4, (yo, SSK) twice, K5 yarn B, K70 yarn A.

Patt row 19 (picot): Cast on 2 sts, cast off 2 sts (1 st on RH needle), K6, (K2tog, yo) twice, K1, (yo, SSK) twice, K4, (yo, SSK) twice, K4 yarn B, K70 yarn A.

Patt row 21: K6, (K2tog, yo) twice, K3, (yo, SSK) twice, K4, (yo, SSK) twice, K3 varn B, K70 yarn A.

Patt row 23 (picot): Cast on 2 sts, cast off 2 sts (1 st on RH needle), K4, (K2tog, yo) twice, K5, (yo, SSK) twice, K1, (K2tog, yo) twice, K5 yarn B, K70 yarn A. Patt row 25: K7, (yo, SSK) twice, K4, yo, SSK, yo, K3tog, yo, K2tog, yo, K6 yarn B, K70 yarn A.

Patt row 27 (picot): Cast on 2 sts, cast off 2 sts (1 st on RH needle), K7, (yo, SSK) twice, K4, yo, K3tog, yo, K2tog, yo, K7 yarn B, K70 yarn A.

Patt row 28: K6, P64 yarn A, K2, P22, K4 yarn B.

These 28 rows form the lace edge patt rep. Rep these 28 rows 3(4) times more, ending with RS facing for next row. Change to 5.5 mm (US 9) needles and work edging rows as folls:

Edging row 1: K28 sts yarn B, K70 sts yarn A.

Edging row 2: K70 sts yarn A, K28 sts yarn B.

Edging row 3 (picot): Cast on 2 sts, cast off 2 sts (1 st on RH needle), K27 sts yarn B, K70 sts yarn A.

Edging row 4: K70 sts yarn A, K28 sts yarn B.

Cast off 28 sts using yarn B, cast off 70 sts using yarn A.
