





General information

The quantities of yarn are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate. It is essential to work to the stated tension and you should always knit a tension square before starting. If you have too many stitches to 10cm/4ins your tension is tight and you should change to a larger needle. If there are too few stitches, your tension is loose and you should change to a smaller needle.

We cannot accept responsibility for the finished product if any yarn other than the one specified is used.

Instructions given are for the first size, with larger sizes in round brackets. Where only one size is given this applies to all sizes. Work all directions in square brackets the number of times stated.

Throw

Approximately 125cm x 142cm/49¼in x 56in

MATERIALS

Jacket 950(1150)g of Noro Kureyon in shade 80.

5mm(US 8) long circular needle.

Pair of 5mm(US 8) knitting needles (for pocket tops only).

6 buttons.

Throw 950g of Noro Kureyon in shade 40.

5mm(US No 8) long circular needle.

TENSION

17 sts and 30 rows to 10cm/4in square, over gst on 5mm (US 8) needles.

One block measures 8.5cm/3¾in diagonally from corner to corner.

ABBREVIATIONS

kfb = K into front and back of next st.

pfb = P into front and back of next st.

Also see page 4.

NOTES

To stop the lower edge pulling in, 3 of the cast on sts are decreased over each 18 row base triangle.

The 1st line of blocks is worked in purl gst, the 2nd line of blocks is worked in knit gst.

To pick up stitches for the blocks, pick up one stitch from between each of the garter stitch ridges.

The jacket and throw are each worked throughout on a long 5mm(US 8) circular needle, but in rows, not in rounds.

Pocket tops are worked on 5mm(US 8) needles.

When working the edgings for the throw, pick up 12 sts from each triangle.

JACKET

BACK

Cast on 96(120) sts.

base triangles

1st row (right side) K2tog, turn.

2nd row K1.

3rd row K2, turn.

4th row K2.

5th row K3, turn.

6th row K3.

7th row K3, k2tog.

8th row K4.

9th row K5, turn.

10th row K5.

11th row K6, turn.

12th row K6.

13th row K6, k2tog.

14th row K7.

15th row K8, turn.

16th row K8.

17th row K9, turn.

18th row K9.

19th row K9, k2tog, turn.

1st to 18th rows form the 1st base triangle.

19th row is the 1st row of the next base triangle. Work 2nd to 19th rows 6(8) more times, then work 2nd to 18th rows.

Next row K9.

8(10) base triangles have been completed.

1st line of blocks

1st side triangle Worked into 9 sts of base triangle.

1st row P1, turn.

2nd row P1.

3rd row P2, turn.

4th row P2.

5th row Pfb, p2tog, turn.

6th row P3.
7th row Pfb, p1, p2tog, turn.
8th row P4.
9th row Pfb, p2, p2tog, turn.
10th row P5.
11th row Pfb, p3, p2tog, turn.
12th row P6.
13th row Pfb, p4, p2tog, turn.
14th row P7.
15th row Pfb, p5, p2tog, turn.
16th row P8.
17th row Pfb, p6, p2tog, turn.
18th row P9.
19th row P9.

Leave these 9 sts.

1st block Purl up 9 sts from row ends of base triangle, turn.

1st row (right side) P9.

2nd row P8, p last st of block tog with 1st st of base triangle, turn.

3rd row P9.

4th row P8, p last st of block tog with next st of base triangle.

5th to 18th rows Work 3rd and 4th rows 7 more times, do not turn at end of 18th row.

All sts of adjacent base triangle have been used. Leave 9 sts of block.

Work 6(8) more blocks between base triangles.

2nd side triangle P up 9 sts from row ends of last base triangle, turn.

1st row P9.

2nd row P9.

3rd row P2tog, p7.

4th row P8.

5th row P2tog, p6.

6th row P7.

7th row P2tog, p5.

8th row P6.

9th row P2tog, p4.

10th row P5.

11th row P2tog, p3.

12th row P4.

13th row P2tog, p2.

14th row P3.

15th row P2tog, p1.

16th row P2.

17th row P2tog.

18th row P1.

Fasten off by enlarging last st and passing the ball of yarn through it. Do not break off yarn. 1st line of blocks has been completed.

2nd line of blocks K up 9 sts from row ends of side triangle.

1st row (wrong side) K9.

2nd row K8, skpo using last st of this block and next st of block in line below, turn.

3rd to 18th rows Work 1st and 2nd rows 8 more times, do not turn at end of 18th row. Leave 9 sts of block. Knitting up sts from row ends of blocks in line below, work 7(9) more blocks. 2nd line of blocks has been completed.

Working into row ends of blocks in line below each time, work 1st and 2nd lines of blocks 8 more times, then work 1st line of blocks again.

1st closing triangle K up 9 sts from row ends of side triangle, turn.

1st row (wrong side) K9.

2nd row K8, skpo using last st of this block and next st of block in line below, turn.

3rd row K7, k2tog.

4th row K7, skpo, turn.

5th row K6, k2tog.

6th row K6, skpo, turn.

7th row K5, k2tog.

8th row K5, skpo, turn.

9th row K4, k2tog.

10th row K4, skpo, turn.

11th row K3, k2tog.

12th row K3, skpo, turn.

13th row K2, k2tog.

14th row K2, skpo, turn.

15th row K1, k2tog.

16th row K1, skpo, turn.

17th row K2tog.

18th row skpo.

Next closing triangle K up 9 sts from row ends of next block in line below, turn.

1st row K8, k2tog. Work 2nd to 18th rows to complete this closing triangle. Cont in this way until all closing triangles have been completed. Fasten off.

POCKET LININGS (Make 2)

Cast on 24 sts. Following instructions for back, work two base triangles, 1st side triangle, one block and 2nd side triangle for 1st line of blocks and two blocks for 2nd line of blocks. Work 1st line of blocks again. Break yarn.

Leave 9 sts of side triangle and 9 sts of block on a holder.

LEFT FRONT

Cast on 48(60) sts. Following instructions for back, work 4(5) base triangles, 1st side triangle, 3(4) blocks and 2nd side triangle for 1st line of blocks and 4(5) blocks for 2nd line of blocks. Work 1st and 2nd lines of blocks

two more times, then work 1st line of blocks again.

Make pocket in next line of blocks

Work 1(2) knit gst blocks, then work 2 closing triangles between blocks in line below, so leaving one st on needle.

Fasten off. With right side facing, insert 1st pocket lining, rejoin yarn and work 2 gst blocks into pocket lining. Work last gst block.

Work 1st and 2nd lines of blocks 3 more times, then work 1st line of blocks again **.

Shape neck

Next line of blocks Work 4(5) gst blocks. Break off yarn.

Leave 9 sts of last block on a holder for neck.

Next line of blocks Omitting 1st side triangle, join yarn, work 3(4) purl gst blocks and 2nd side triangle.

Next line of blocks Work 3(4) gst blocks.

Next line of blocks Work 1st side triangle, 2(3) purl gst blocks and 2nd side triangle. Work 3(4) closing triangles.

RIGHT FRONT

Work as left front to **.

Shape neck

Next line of blocks Work 4(5) gst blocks.

Next line of blocks Work 1st side triangle and 3(4) purl gst blocks.

Break yarn and leave 9 sts of last block on a holder for neck.

Next line of blocks Work 3(4) gst blocks.

Next line of blocks Work 1st side triangle, 2(3) purl gst blocks and 2nd side triangle. Work 3(4) closing triangles.

SLEEVES

Cast on 50(56) sts.

K 37 rows.

Inc row Kfb, k to last 2 sts, kfb, k1.

Inc in this way at each end of every 8th row until there are 80(86) sts.

K 6 rows.

Cast off.

EDGINGS

Pocket tops With right side facing and 5mm(US 8) needles, k up 26 sts along pocket edge.

K 4 rows. Cast off.

Back With right side facing, k up 96(120) sts along lower edge of back.

K 4 rows. Cast off.

Fronts With right side facing, k up 48(60) sts along lower edge of each front. K 4 rows. Cast off.

FRONT BANDS

With right side facing, k up 100 sts up right front edge and 9 sts from row ends of first block, break yarn, slip 9 sts of next block, k up 12 sts from side triangle up right front neck, k up 24 sts from closing triangles across back neck, k up 12 sts down side triangle and 9 sts from row ends of next block, break yarn, slip 9 sts of last block of left side of neck, k up 100 sts down left front edge. 284 sts.

K 3 rows.

Buttonhole row (right side) K36, skpo, yon twice, k2tog, [k8, skpo, yon twice, k2tog] 5 times, k to end.

Next row K, working into back of each yon. K 1 row.

Next row (wrong side) Cast off 104 sts, k until there are 76 sts on right needle, cast off 104 sts.

COLLAR

With right side facing, join yarn to remaining 76 sts and k 43 rows. Cast off.

TO MAKE UP

Press according to ball band. Place markers 23.5(25)cm down from shoulders on back and fronts. Sew sleeves between markers. Join side and sleeve seams. Catch down pocket linings and ends of pocket tops. Sew on buttons.

THROW

TO MAKE

Cast on 168 sts.

Follow instructions for stitch pattern as given for Back of Jacket.

Work 14 base triangles.

1st line of blocks Work 1st side triangle, 13 purl gst blocks and 2nd side triangle.

2nd line of blocks Work 14 knit gst blocks. Work 1st and 2nd lines of blocks 14 more times, then work 1st line of blocks again. Work 14 closing triangles.

EDGINGS

Top With right side facing, k up 168 sts along closing triangles.

K 1 row.

Inc row (right side) Kfb, k to last 2 sts, kfb, k1.

Cont in gst, inc in this way on next 3 right side rows. 176 sts.

Cast off.

Bottom Work as for top edging along base triangles in the same way.

Sides With right side facing, k up 192 sts from 1st side triangles edge. Work as top edging until there are 200 sts.

Cast off.

Work 2nd side triangles edging in the same way.

TO MAKE UP

Join ends of edgings. Press according to ball band.

To make a buggy blanket size throw measuring approximately 57 x 74cm/ 22½ x 29¼in you will need 250g of Noro Kureyon. Following instructions for large throw, cast on 72 sts and work 6 base triangles, 1st and 2nd lines of blocks 7 times, 1st line of blocks again and 6 closing triangles. For the top and bottom edgings, pick up 72 sts. Work as top edging of large throw until there are 80 sts. Cast off. For the side edgings k up 96 sts. Work as top edging until there are 104 sts. Cast off.

Make up as large throw.
