WEEK™

Week A40

FOR EXPERIENCED KNITTERS ONLY!

YARN: 10 (11, 11) skeins Dorothee Bis Fermette color 1.



PATTERNS:

Cable Pattern over 12 sts.

Row 1: K2 tog, K1, yo, K1, K4 for cable, K1, yo, K1, ssk

Row 2: P3, K1, P4, K1, P3

Row 3: K2 tog, yo, K2, K4 for cable, K2, yo, ssk

Row 4: P3, K1, P4, K1, P3

Row 5: K2 tog, K1, yo, K1, sl 2 sts onto dpn and hold in back, K2, K2 from dpn, K1, yo, K1, ssk

Row 6: Same as row 4

Repeat rows 1-6 for pattern

Cable Pattern over 4 sts.

Rows 1 & 3: K4

Rows 2, 4 & 6: P4

Row 5: Sl 2 onto dpn and hold in back, K2, K2 from dpn

Chevron Pattern:

Row 1: K2 tog, K1, yo, K1, yo, K1, ssk

Row 2: Purl

Row 3: K2 tog, yo, K3, yo, ssk

Row 4: Purl

Repeat rows 1-4 for pattern

Twist Pattern: Worked on 4 sts.

Row 1: K1, pass right needle behind first stitch on left needle, knit second stitch, then knit first st and drop both sts off left needle tog, K1

Row 2: K1, pass right needle in front of first st, purl second st, then purl first st and drop both sts off left needle tog, K1

NOTE: Pattern is worked from the neck down.

ssk = slip 1, K1, pss0

G = garter stitch (knit both sides)

yo before and after Twist pattern is used as an increase to form the shaping. There will be 8 sts more on every knit row. Yo's are made before first marker and after second marker.

SIZES: 34 (36, 38) finished measurement approximately 1" larger.

NEEDLES: #6 & #8 or whatever size is necessary to obtain gauge. 1 double pointed needle (dpn) or cable needle.

With Fermette color 1 and #8 needle, cast on 88 sts. Knit 5 rows of garter stitch, placing markers on the fifth row as follows:

K13 (left front), marker, K4, marker, K10 (sleeve), marker, K4, marker, K26 (back), marker, K4, marker, K10 (sleeve), marker, K4, marker, K13 (right front)

Work the next row and every right side row putting a yo before the first and after the second marker that separate each set of the 4 knit sts. Purl the next row. You now have 8 more sts (96) on your needle.

On the next row (right side) start pattern.

(Front) G3, cable pattern over 4 sts, G1, yo, K1, ssk, K3, yo,

(Raglan) marker, twist pattern over 4 sts, marker,

(Sleeve) yo, K0, cable pattern over 12 sts, K0, yo,

(Raglan) marker, twist pattern over 4 sts, marker,

(Back) yo, K0, cable pattern over 12 sts, K0, yo,

(Raglan) marker, twist pattern over 4 sts, marker,

(Sleeve) yo, K0, cable over 12 sts, K0, yo,

(Raglan) marker, twist pattern over 4 sts, marker

(Front) yo, K3, K2 tog, K1, yo, G1, cable pattern over 4 sts, G3

GAUGE: 4½ sts & 6 rows = 1"

Work row 2 of the various patterns purling those sts not in patterns or designated as G sts. Those numbers underlined in the row above will increase by one on each right side row. Continuing working as set following patterns and working yo's as indicated. When piece measures 3½", work in one Chevron pattern on either side of cable pattern on each sleeve once (over 4 rows). Then place one more Chevron pattern on each side of last Chevron pattern once. Continue adding one more chevron to each side of sleeve until there are 4 chevron patterns on each side of cable pattern on sleeves.

When piece measures 8 (8½, 9½)", place sts for sleeves on 2 holders. Place sts for back on a holder. Pick up sts for front on one needle starting at armband edge and ending opposite armband edge. Work in stockinette stitch joining at center. When front measures 11 (12, 13)" from underarm, change to smaller needles and K1, P1 rib for 2". Bind off sts. Work back in the same manner. Pick up sts for sleeve and continue in pattern until sleeves measure 6 (7, 8)" from underarm. Change to smaller needles and work in garter st for 5 rows. Bind off sts.

FINISHING: Sew side seams of sweater and sleeves. Make a chain st at the top of neck opening on each side of neck edge. Weave front edge at bottom of slit for 1".
