





## General Information

The quantities of yarn are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate. It is essential to work to the stated tension and you should always knit a tension square before starting. If you have too many stitches to 10cm/4in your tension is tight and you should change to a larger needle. If there are too few stitches, your tension is loose and you should change to a smaller needle.

We cannot accept responsibility for the finished product if any yarn other than the one specified is used.

Instructions given are for the first size, with larger sizes in round brackets. Where only one size is given this applies to all sizes. Work all directions in square brackets the number of times stated.

When working with random dyed yarn, to avoid a sudden jump in colour when starting a new ball, start at a similar place in the colour shading.

See ball band for washing and pressing instructions.

## MATERIALS

500(550:600)g of Noro Iro in shade 21.  
 Pair each 7mm(US 10½) and 7½mm(US 11)  
 knitting needles.  
 6 buttons.

## TENSION

12 sts and 22 rows to 10cm/4in square over  
 moss st using 7½mm(US 11) needles.

## ABBREVIATIONS

See page 6.

## BACK

With 7mm(US 10½) needles cast on  
 51(57:63) sts.  
 K 27(31:35) rows.

Change to 7½mm(US 11) needles.

**1st row** (right side) P1, \* k1, p1; rep from \*  
 to end.

This row sets the moss st patt and is  
 repeated.

Work in patt until back measures  
 46(51:56)cm/18(20:22)in from beg, ending  
 with a wrong side row.

### Shape shoulders

Cast off 9(10:11) sts at beg of next 4 rows.

Cast off rem 15(17:19) sts.

## LEFT POCKET LINING

With 7½mm(US 11) needles cast on  
 24(26:30) sts.

**1st row** (right side) \* K1, p1; rep from \* to  
 end.

**2nd row** \* P1, k1; rep from \* to end.

These 2 rows form the moss st.

Cont in moss st until pocket measures  
 14(15:16)cm/5½(6:6½)in ending with a right  
 side row.

Leave sts on a holder.

## LEFT FRONT

With 7mm(US 10½) needles cast on  
 28(30:34) sts.

K26(30:34) rows.

**Next row** (wrong side) K24(25:28), turn.

**Next row** K to end.

**Next row** K20(20:22), turn.

**Next row** K to end.

**Next row** K16, turn.

**Next row** K to end.

**Next row** K12, turn.

**Next row** K to end.

**Next row** K8, turn.

**Next row** K to end.

**Next row** K4, turn.

**Next row** K to end.

**Next row** K to end.

**Next row** Cast off 24(26:30) sts, k to end.

Change to 7½mm(US 11) needles.

**Next row** (wrong side) K4, work in moss st  
 across pocket lining.

**Next row** \* K1, p1; rep from \* to last 4 sts,  
 k4.

**Next row** K4, \* p1, k1; rep from \* to end.

These 2 rows set the moss st patt with  
 garter st border.

Cont straight until front measures  
 41(46:50)cm/16(18:19½)in from beg, ending  
 with a wrong side row.

### Shape neck

**Next row** Patt to last 6 sts, turn and slip  
 these 6 sts onto a holder.

Dec one st at neck edge on every row until  
 18(20:22) sts rem.

Work straight until front matches back to  
 shoulder, ending at side edge.

### Shape shoulder

**Next row** Cast off 9(10:11) sts, patt to end.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 9(10:11) sts.

Mark the position for 6 buttons - the first

7(9:11)cm/2½(3½:4¼)in from cast on edge, the sixth 1cm/½in from neck edge, the rem 4 spaced evenly between.

### RIGHT POCKET LINING

With 7½mm(US 11) needles cast on 24(26:30) sts.

**1st row** (right side) \* P1, k1; rep from \* to end.

**2nd row** \* K1, p1; rep from \* to end.

These 2 rows form the moss st.

Cont in moss st until pocket measures 14(15:16)cm/5½(6:6¼) ending with a wrong side row.

Leave sts on a holder.

### RIGHT FRONT

With 7mm(US 10½) needles cast on 28(30:34) sts.

Working buttonholes to match button markers as follows:

**Buttonhole row** (right side) K1, k2tog, yf, k1, patt to end.

K25(29:33) rows.

**Next row** (right side) K24(25:28), turn.

**Next row** K to end.

**Next row** K20(20:22), turn.

**Next row** K to end.

**Next row** K16, turn.

**Next row** K to end.

**Next row** K12, turn.

**Next row** K to end.

**Next row** K8, turn.

**Next row** K to end.

**Next row** K4, turn.

**Next row** K to end.

**Next row** K to end.

**Next row** Cast off 24(26:30) sts, k to end. Change to 7½mm(US 11) needles.

**Next row** (right side) K4, work in moss st across pocket lining.

**Next row** \* K1, p1; rep from \* to last 4 sts, k4.

**Next row** K4, \* p1, k1; rep from \* to end.

The last 2 rows set the moss st patt with garter st border.

Cont straight until front measures 41(46:50)cm/16(18:19¼)in from beg, ending with a wrong side row.

### Shape neck

**Next row** Patt 6 sts, leave these sts on a holder, patt to end.

Dec one st at neck edge on every row until 18(20:22) sts rem.

Work straight until front matches back to shoulder, ending at side edge.

### Shape shoulder

**Next row** Cast off 9(10:11) sts, patt to end.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 9(10:11) sts.

### SLEEVES

With 7½mm(US 11) needles cast on 33(35:37) sts.

K 5 rows.

Work in moss st as given for Back until sleeve measures 5(6:6)cm/2(2½:2½)in from beg ending with a wrong side row.

Change to 7mm(US 10½) needles.

Work a further 5(6:6)cm/2(2½:2½)in moss st.

Change to 7½mm(US 11) needles.

Cont in moss st, inc one st at each end of the next and every foll 4th row until there are 47(53:59) sts.

Work straight until sleeve measures 28(31:34)cm/11(12¼:13½)in from cast on edge, ending with a wrong side row.

Cast off.

### COLLAR

Join shoulder seams.

With right side facing and 7mm(US 10½) needles, slip 6 sts from right front holder onto a needle, pick up and k10 sts up right front neck, 21(23:25) sts across back neck, 10 sts down left front neck, then k6 sts from holder. 53(55:57) sts.

**Next row** K5, moss st to last 5 sts, k5.

This row sets the patt for moss st with garter st edge.

**Next 2 rows** Patt to last 14 sts, turn.

**Next 2 rows** Patt to last 12 sts, turn.

**Next 2 rows** Patt to last 10 sts, turn.

**Next 2 rows** Patt to last 8 sts, turn.

Patt to end.

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows.

47(49:51) sts.

**Next row** Patt to end.

**Next row** K3, m1, moss st to last 3 sts, m1, k3.

**Next 3 rows** K3, moss st to last 3 sts, k3.

Rep the last 4 rows once more.

K 5 rows.

Cast off.

### TO MAKE UP

Sew down pocket linings. Sew on sleeves.

Join side and sleeve seams. Sew on buttons.

Turn back cuffs.
